¹ We then, as workers together with Him also plead with you not to receive the grace of God in vain. ² For He says:

"In an acceptable time I have heard you, And in the day of salvation I have helped you." Behold, now is the accepted time; behold, now is the day of salvation.

Our example of ministry

³ We give no offense in anything, that our ministry may not be blamed. ⁴ But in all things we commend ourselves as ministers of God: in much patience, in tribulations, in needs, in distresses, ⁵ in stripes, in imprisonments, in tumults, in labors, in sleeplessness, in fastings; ⁶ by purity, by knowledge, by longsuffering, by kindness, by the Holy Spirit, by sincere love, ⁷ by the word of truth, by the power of God, by the armor of righteousness on the right hand and on the left, ⁸ by honor and dishonor, by evil report and good report; as deceivers, and yet true; ⁹ as unknown, and yet well known; as dying, and behold we live; as chastened, and yet not killed; ¹⁰ as sorrowful, yet always rejoicing; as poor, yet making many rich; as having nothing, and yet possessing all things.

Call to openness

11 O Corinthians! We have spoken openly to you, our heart is wide open. 12 You are not restricted by us, but you are restricted by your own affections. 13 Now in return for the same (I speak as to children), you also be open.

Do not be unequally yoked with unbelievers

14 Do not be unequally yoked together with unbelievers. For what fellowship has righteousness with lawlessness? And what communion has light with darkness? 15 And what accord has Christ with Belial? Or what part has a believer with an unbeliever? 16 And what agreement has the temple of God with idols? For you are the temple of the living God. As God has said:

"I will dwell in them And walk among them. I will be their God, And they shall be My people."

Come out from among them and be separate

Facts Revealed:

- \$\Psi\$ We as coworkers with Christ plead with you not to receive the grace of God in vain.
 - ♦ It is possible to receive the Gospel message in vain as expressed by Jesus saying: Matthew 7:24-27
 - ²⁴ "Therefore whoever **hears these sayings of Mine**, and **does them**, I will liken him to a wise man who built his house on the rock: ²⁵ and the rain descended, the floods came, and the winds blew and beat on that house; and it did not fall, for it was founded on the rock.

26 Now everyone who **hears these sayings of Mine**, and **does not do them**, will be like a foolish man who built his house on the sand: 27 and the rain descended, the floods came, and the winds blew and beat on that house; and it fell. And great was its fall." NKJV

♦ Paul quotes Isaiah:

"In an acceptable time I have heard you, And in the day of salvation I have helped you." [Isaiah 49:8]

♦ Paul's application:

Behold, now is the accepted time; behold, now is the day of salvation.

- ❖ To receive the Gospel message effectively we must believe it and act on it in obedience to the teachings of Jesus.
- ♦ To receive the Gospel message without believing and acting on it is to receive it in vain. Our example of ministry [2 Corinthians 6:3-10]
 - ♥ We do everything possible to avoid offending in anything, that our ministry may not be blamed.
 - \$\frac{1}{2}\$ By our example we commend ourselves as ministers of God. We have been faithful:
 - ❖ Patience, tribulations, needs, distresses, stripes, imprisonments, tumults, labors, sleeplessness, fastings, purity, knowledge, longsuffering, kindness.
 - ♦ By the Holy Spirit, sincere love, word of truth, power of God.
 - ♦ Our armor is righteousness on the right and on the left.
 - ♦ We are viewed with honor and dishonor.
 - ♦ We have been reported with evil report and good report.
 - ♦ We have been accused as being deceivers, yet we remain true.
 - ♦ We are unknown, yet well known.
 - ♦ We are under the threat of death, yet we live.
 - ♦ We are chastened, yet not killed.
 - ♦ We experience sorrow, yet always rejoicing.
 - ♦ We are poor, yet we make many rich.
 - ♦ We have nothing, yet we possess all things.

Call to openness [2 Corinthians 6:11-13]

- ♦ We have spoken openly to you and our hearts are open toward you.
 - ♦ You are not restricted by us, but by your own affections.
 - ♦ We therefore ask you to be open to us.

Do not be unequally yoked with unbelievers [2 Corinthians 6:14-16]

- † It is not fitting for believers to be unequally yoked with unbelievers in marriage or business.
 - ♦ For what fellowship has righteousness with lawlessness?
 - ♦ And what communion has light with darkness?
 - ♦ And what accord has Christ with Belial?
 - ♦ Or what part has a believer with an unbeliever?
 - ♦ And what agreement has the temple of God with idols?
- ♣ God has said:
 - "I will dwell in them And walk among them. I will be their God, And they shall be My people." [Leviticus 26:12]
 - ♦ This has been the desire of the heart of God from the beginning and remains so to the end. [Exodus 5:1, 6:7, Leviticus 26:12, Psalm 50:7, Jeremiah 7:23, 11:4, 24:7, 30:22, 31:1, 31:33, 32:38, Ezekiel 11:20, 14:11, 34:30, 36:28, 37:23, 27, Hosea 2:23, Zechariah 8:8, 13:9, 2 Corinthians 6:16, Hebrews 8:10, Revelation 21:3]
