Death of Ben-Hadad king of Syria - Hazael becomes king in his place

7 Then Elisha went to Damascus, and Ben-Hadad king of Syria was sick; and it was told him, saying, "The man of God has come here." 8 And the king said to Hazael, "Take a present in your hand, and go to meet the man of God, and inquire of the Lord by him, saying, 'Shall I recover from this disease?" 9 So Hazael went to meet him and took a present with him, of every good thing of Damascus, forty camel-loads; and he came and stood before him, and said, "Your son Ben-Hadad king of Syria has sent me to you, saying, 'Shall I recover from this disease?"

¹⁰ And Elisha said to him, "Go, say to him, 'You shall certainly recover.' However the Lord has shown me that he will really die." ¹¹ Then he set his countenance in a stare until he was ashamed; and the man of God wept. ¹² And Hazael said, "Why is my lord weeping?"

He answered, "Because I know the evil that you will do to the children of Israel: Their strongholds you will set on fire, and their young men you will kill with the sword; and you will dash their children, and rip open their women with child."

13 So Hazael said, "But what is your servant — a dog, that he should do this gross thing?"

And Elisha answered, "The Lord has shown me that you will become king over Syria."

¹⁴ Then he departed from Elisha, and came to his master, who said to him, "What did Elisha say to you?" And he answered, "He told me you would surely recover." ¹⁵ But it happened on the next day that he took a thick cloth and dipped it in water, and spread it over his face so that he died; and Hazael reigned in his place. Facts Revealed:

Death of Ben-Hadad king of Syria – Hazael becomes king in his place [2 Kings 8:7-15]

- The command to anoint Hazael as king of Syria was given to Elijah by Yahweh at the cave in Mount Horeb. [1 Kings 19:15] see [1 Kings 19:1-18]
 - ♦ Elisha accomplished the commandment at an opportune time. [2 Kings 8:7-15]
 - ♦ Elisha went to Damascus when Ben-Hadad king of Syria was sick. [2 Kings 8:7]
 - ♦ When Ben-Hadad heard that Elisha the man of Elohiym was in town he sent a present by the hand of Hazael to inquire if he would recover from his sickness. [2 Kings 8:8]
 - ♦ Hazael brought to Elisha 40 camel loads of every good thing of Damascus, with the inquiry regarding Ben-Hadad's sickness. [2 Kings 8:9]
- Elisha said to him, "Go, say to him, 'You shall certainly recover.' However the Lord has shown me that he will really die." [2 Kings 8:10]
 - ♦ The sickness is not fatal, but Ben-Hadad will die anyway.
 - Elisha stared as in a trance, and began to weep. Hazael asked why he was weeping. [2 Kings 8:11-12]
- Elisha answered, "Because I know the evil that you will do to the children of Israel: Their strongholds you will set on fire, and their young men you will kill with the sword; and you will dash their children, and rip open their women with child." [2 Kings 8:12]
 - ♦ The Holy Spirit revealed in detail to Elisha the things that would come upon Israel at the hands of Hazael.

- ☆ Hazael said, "But what is your servant a dog, that he should do this great mighty thing?"
 [2 Kings 8:13]
- Elisha answered, "The Lord has shown me that you will become king over Syria." [2 Kings 8:13]
- ☆ When Hazael returned, Ben-Hadad asked what Elisha said about his sickness. Hazael told him that the sickness was not fatal and he would recover from it. [2 Kings 8:14]
- ★ But it happened on the next day that Hazael took a thick cloth and dipped it in water, and spread it over Ben-Hadad's face so that he died; and Hazael reigned in his place.

 ♦ The words of Elisha proved true.
 - ♦ Yahweh had said to Elijah in the cave on Mount Horeb,
 - 15 Then Yahweh (the Lord) said to Elijah: "Go, return on your way to the Wilderness of Damascus; and when you arrive, <u>anoint Hazael as king over Syria</u>. 16 Also you shall <u>anoint Jehu the son of Nimshi as king over Israel</u>. And <u>Elisha the son of</u> <u>Shaphat of Abel Meholah you shall anoint as prophet in your place</u>. 17 **It shall be** that whoever escapes the sword of Hazael, Jehu will kill; and whoever escapes the sword of Jehu, Elisha will kill. [1 Kings 19:15-17]
