# Deuteronomy 10:12-22 **Greatness of God and What does God Require of You** Fear and Obey God with all your heart and soul

<sup>12</sup> "And now, Israel, what does the LORD your God require of you, but to fear the LORD your God, to walk in all His ways and to love Him, to serve the LORD your God with all your heart and with all your soul, <sup>13</sup> and to keep the commandments of the LORD and His statutes which I command you today for your good?

## Greatness of God Who loves you for the sake of your Fathers

<sup>14</sup> Indeed heaven and the highest heavens belong to the LORD your God, also the earth with all that is in it. <sup>15</sup> The LORD delighted only in your fathers, to love them; and He chose their descendants after them, you above all peoples, as it is this day.

## Circumcise your Hearts

<sup>16</sup> Therefore circumcise the foreskin of your heart, and be stiff-necked no longer.

## Your God is God of gods, and Lord of lords, Mighty and Awesome, yet impartial

<sup>17</sup> For the LORD your God is God of gods and Lord of lords, the great God, mighty and awesome, who shows no partiality nor takes a bribe. <sup>18</sup> He administers justice for the fatherless and the widow, and loves the stranger, giving him food and clothing.

#### **Righteous Behavior**

<sup>19</sup> Therefore love the stranger, for you were strangers in the land of Egypt. <sup>20</sup> You shall fear the LORD your God; you shall serve Him, and to Him you shall hold fast, and take oaths in His name.

<sup>21</sup> He is your praise, and He is your God, who has done for you these great and awesome things which your eyes have seen. <sup>22</sup> Your fathers went down to Egypt with seventy persons, and now the LORD your God has made you as the stars of heaven in multitude. NKJV

Greatness of God Who loves you for the sake of your Fathers [Deuteronomy 10:14-15]

- All creation in Heaven and Earth and all that is in them belong to Yehowah Eloheyk (the Lord your God). [Genesis 2:4, 14:22, Exodus 9:29, Deuteronomy 10:14, Psalm 24:1]
- ☆ Yehowah delighted to love your fathers, and has chosen their descendants after them, you above all peoples, as it is this day. [Deuteronomy 7:6, 10:15]

#### Circumcise your Hearts

A submissive heart is more important than circumcision of the flesh. [Deuteronomy 10:16, 30:6, Jeremiah 4:4, Romans 2:25-29]

Your God is God of gods, and Lord of lords, Mighty and Awesome, yet impartial [Deuteronomy 10:17-18]

- Yehowah Eloheykm is Elohey of Elohiym and Adoney of Adonaym, the Gadol El, Gibbor, vahnovraa (the LORD your God is God of gods and Lord of lords, the great God, mighty and awesome) [Deuteronomy 10:17]
- God shows no partiality, nor takes a bribe. [Deuteronomy 10:17, 2 Chronicles 19:7, Romans 2:11, Ephesians 6:9]
- ☆ He administers justice for the fatherless and the widow, and loves the stranger, giving him food and clothing. [Deuteronomy 10:18]

Righteous Behavior. [Deuteronomy 10:19-20]

- $\Leftrightarrow$  Love the Stranger.
  - ♦ Your experience as afflicted strangers in Egypt should help you understand the righteousness of loving the stranger in your midst.
- ☆ You shall fear Yehowah Eloheyk.
- ✤ You shall serve Him.
- $\Rightarrow$  You shall hold fast to Him.
- ☆ You shall take oaths in His Name. [Deuteronomy 6:13]
