

Deuteronomy 11:22-32 **Blessing or Curse - Obedience**

Promise for Obedience

22 "For if you carefully keep all these commandments which I command you to do--to love the LORD your God, to walk in all His ways, and to hold fast to Him-- 23 then the LORD will drive out all these nations from before you, and you will dispossess greater and mightier nations than yourselves. 24 Every place on which the sole of your foot treads shall be yours: from the wilderness and Lebanon, from the river, the River Euphrates, even to the Western Sea, shall be your territory. 25 No man shall be able to stand against you; the LORD your God will put the dread of you and the fear of you upon all the land where you tread, just as He has said to you.

Blessing on Mount Gerizim, Curse on Mount Ebal

26 "Behold, I set before you today a blessing and a curse: 27 the blessing, if you obey the commandments of the LORD your God which I command you today; 28 and the curse, if you do not obey the commandments of the LORD your God, but turn aside from the way which I command you today, to go after other gods which you have not known. 29 Now it shall be, when the LORD your God has brought you into the land which you go to possess, that you shall put the blessing on Mount Gerizim and the curse on Mount Ebal. 30 Are they not on the other side of the Jordan, toward the setting sun, in the land of the Canaanites who dwell in the plain opposite Gilgal, beside the terebinth trees of Moreh?

You Will Possess the Land – You Must Obey God’s Laws

31 For you will cross over the Jordan and go in to possess the land which the LORD your God is giving you, and you will possess it and dwell in it. 32 And you shall be careful to observe all the statutes and judgments which I set before you today. NKJV

Facts Revealed:

Promise for Obedience [Deuteronomy 11:22-25]

- ✧ **If you carefully keep all these commandments** which I command you to do--**to love the LORD your God, to walk in all His ways, and to hold fast to Him.** [Deuteronomy 11:22] see also [Deuteronomy 6:4-5, 10:12-14, 20]
- ✧ Yehowah (the LORD) will drive out all these nations from before you, and you will dispossess greater and mightier nations than yourselves. [Exodus 34:24, Deuteronomy 4:37-38, 7:1, 17-24, 9:1-6, 11:23]
- ✧ **Every place on which the sole of your foot treads** shall be yours: from the **wilderness and Lebanon**, from the river, the **River Euphrates**, even to the **Western Sea**, shall be your territory. [Deuteronomy 11:24, Joshua 1:1-5]
- ✧ **No man shall be able to stand against you.** [Deuteronomy 7:17-24, 11:25, Joshua 1:1-5]
- ✧ **Yehowah Eloheykm** (the LORD your God) **will put the dread of you and the fear of you upon all the land where you tread**, just as He has said to you. [Deuteronomy 2:24-25, 11:25]

Blessing on Mount Gerizim, Curse on Mount Ebal [Deuteronomy 11:26-30]

- ✧ Behold, I set before you today a **blessing** and a **curse**: [Deuteronomy 11:26]
- ✧ **Blessing**, if you obey the commandments of the LORD your God which I command you today. [Deuteronomy 11:27]
- ✧ **Curse**, if you do not obey the commandments of the LORD your God, but turn aside from the way which I command you today, to go after other gods which you have not known. [Deuteronomy 11:28]

☆ **When the LORD your God has brought you into the land which you go to possess:**

✧ You shall put the **blessing on Mount Gerizim** and the **curse on Mount Ebal**. [Deuteronomy 11:29]

❖ They are on the west side of the Jordan, in the land of the Canaanites who dwell in the plain opposite Gilgal, beside the Terebinth Trees of Moreh. [Deuteronomy 11:30]

You Will Possess the Land – You Must Obey God’s Laws [Deuteronomy 11:31-32]

☆ You shall possess the Land and dwell in it. [Leviticus 20:22-24, Numbers 33:50-53, Deuteronomy 1:39, 3:18-20, 4:1, 22, 5:31-33, 6:1, 11:8-12, 11:31]

☆ You shall be careful to obey all the statutes and judgments I set before you today. [Deuteronomy 11:32] see also [Genesis 26:1-5, Exodus 15:26, Leviticus 18:5, 24-30, 19:37, 20:8, 22-26, 25:18, Deuteronomy 5:1, 6:1-3, 16-25, 7:11, 10:12-13, 11:1, 32]
