Deuteronomy 14:22-29 **Tithes**

Eat your Tithes in the place Yehowah Eloheykm chooses to make His Name abide

²² "You shall truly tithe all the increase of your grain that the field produces year by year. ²³ And you shall eat before the LORD your God, in the place where He chooses to make His name abide, the tithe of your grain and your new wine and your oil, of the firstborn of your herds and your flocks, that you may learn to fear the LORD your God always.

If the distance is too great

²⁴ But if the journey is too long for you, so that you are not able to carry the tithe, or if the place where the LORD your God chooses to put His name is too far from you, when the LORD your God has blessed you, ²⁵ then you shall exchange it for money, take the money in your hand, and go to the place which the LORD your God chooses. ²⁶ And you shall spend that money for whatever your heart desires: for oxen or sheep, for wine or similar drink, for whatever your heart desires; you shall eat there before the LORD your God, and you shall rejoice, you and your household. ²⁷ You shall not forsake the Levite who is within your gates, for he has no part nor inheritance with you.

The Third Year

²⁸ "At the end of every third year you shall bring out the tithe of your produce of that year and store it up within your gates. ²⁹ And the Levite, because he has no portion nor inheritance with you, and the stranger and the fatherless and the widow who are within your gates, may come and eat and be satisfied, that the LORD your God may bless you in all the work of your hand which you do. NKJV

Facts Revealed:

- \Psi You must surely tithe all your increase year by year. [Genesis 14:18-20, 28:22, Leviticus 27:30-33, Numbers 18:1-32, Deuteronomy 12:10-27, 14:22-29, 26:12-15]
 - ♦ Grain, Wine, Oil.
 - ♦ Firstborn of your flocks and herds.
- **☆** That you may learn to fear Yehowah Eloheyk always.

If the distance is too great to carry the tithe [Deuteronomy 14:24-27]

- **⋄** Spend that money for whatever your heart desires:
 - ♦ For oxen or sheep, for wine or similar drink, for whatever your heart desires.
 - ♦ Eat there before Yehowah Eloheyk (the LORD your God).
 - ♦ And you shall rejoice, you and your household.
 - ❖ Do not forsake the Levite who is within your gates, for he has no part nor inheritance with you.

The Third Year [Deuteronomy 14:28-29, 26:12-15]

- **☼** The Tithe of the Third Year is for:
 - ♦ The Levite, because he has no portion nor inheritance with you.
 - ♦ The stranger and the fatherless and the widow who are within your gates.
- **☼** The Tithe is stored up within your gates that:
 - ♦ The Levite, Stranger, Fatherless, and Widow may come and eat and be satisfied
 - ♦ Yehowah Eloheyk (the LORD your God) may bless you in all the work of your hand which you do.
