# Deuteronomy 15:1-6 Seventh Year Release

<sup>1</sup> "At the end of every seven years you shall grant a release of debts.

## Release debt of your Neighbor or Brother, not foreigner

<sup>2</sup> And this is the form of the release: Every creditor who has lent anything to his neighbor shall release it; he shall not require it of his neighbor or his brother, because it is called the LORD's release. <sup>3</sup> Of a foreigner you may require it; but you shall give up your claim to what is owed by your brother, <sup>4</sup> except when there may be no poor among you;

### God's Great Blessing If You Carefully Obey All His Commandments

for the LORD will greatly bless you in the land which the LORD your God is giving you to possess as an inheritance-- 5 only if you carefully obey the voice of the LORD your God, to observe with care all these commandments which I command you today. 6 For the LORD your God will bless you just as He promised you; you shall lend to many nations, but you shall not borrow; you shall reign over many nations, but they shall not reign over you. NKJV

#### Facts Revealed:

### Seventh year debt release

- $\Rightarrow$  At the end of every seven years you shall grant a release of debts.
  - $\diamond$  Release debt of your neighbor or brother.
  - $\diamond$  It is called Yehowah's Release.
  - $\diamond$  You are not required to release the debt of a foreigner.
  - $\diamond$  This continues to apply except when there are no poor among you.

## God's Great Blessing If You Carefully Obey All His Commandments [Deuteronomy 15:4-6]

- God's plan and desire is to bless all the Children of Israel in abundance, peace, and health.
- ☆ That will be the characteristic of the Kingdom Age when God will reign over the entire earth from His throne in Jerusalem for a thousand years. [Isaiah 2:4-5, 4:2-6, 11:6-9, 30:23-24, 65:18-25]
- $\Rightarrow$  However there is a requirement for receiving that blessing.
  - ☆ That requirement is for everyone in the kingdom to carefully obey the voice of the LORD your God, to observe with care all these commandments which I command you today.
  - Only when God's will is done on earth as it is in Heaven, will there truly be peace, prosperity, health, and no poor among you. [Isaiah 1:26-27, 9:2-7, 33:5-6, 13-24, Jeremiah 3:16-17, 31:33-34, Daniel 7:27, Micah 4:3, 6:6-8, Habakkuk 2:14, Matthew 6:10, Luke 11:2]
  - ☆ That is why in His model prayer, Jesus said to pray, "Thy Kingdom come, Thy Will be done on earth as it is in Heaven." [Matthew 6:10, Luke 11:2] He was looking forward to the Kingdom age when it will truly and literally be fulfilled.
- Then Yehowah Eloheyk (the LORD your God) will bless you just as He promised you; you shall lend to many nations, but you shall not borrow; you shall reign over many nations, but they shall not reign over you.
- ♥ Until then, we know that there will always be poor among you. [Deuteronomy 15:11]
  - ♦ Because God knows that there will never be a time when <u>all</u> His people keep <u>all</u> His commandments until He sets up His Own Kingdom in the last days, the Kingdom age.
