Deuteronomy 18:20-22 False Prophet

²⁰ But the prophet who presumes to speak a word in My name, which I have not commanded him to speak, or who speaks in the name of other gods, that prophet shall die.' ²¹ "And if you say in your heart, 'How shall we know the word which the LORD has not spoken?'-- ²² when a prophet speaks in the name of the LORD, if the thing does not happen or come to pass, that is the thing which the LORD has not spoken; the prophet has spoken it presumptuously; you shall not be afraid of him. NKJV

Facts Revealed:

- ☆ Just as sure as the fact that God will send His true prophet with the actual words of God;
- ☆ There will arise false prophets speaking presumptuously on their own with their own motivation.
 - \diamond These false prophets will bring a message that is not from God.
 - \diamond Or they will speak in the name of other gods.
- \Rightarrow The penalty for the false prophet is death.
- \Rightarrow The test of a prophet who speaks in the name of Yehowah is, if it comes to pass or not.
 - ✤ If the thing he predicted does not come to pass, it is evidence that he has spoken presumptuously. Do not be afraid of him.
- ☆ The test of a prophet that comes in the name of another god is self evident by the identity of the god in whose name he speaks.
- ☆ The Prophets of God have dealt with false prophets from of old. [1 Kings 18:1-40, 22:1-40, 2 Chronicles 18:21-22, Isaiah 8:19, 9:15, 59:11-13, Jeremiah 5:30-31, 6:13, 8:10, 14:14, 23:32, 29:9, Lamentations 2:14, Ezekiel 22:28, Micah 2:10-11]
- Jesus the Messiah and the apostles indicated that in the last days there will be many false prophets who come on the scene, speaking in the name of Yehowah or in the name of Jesus, and they will deceive many. [Matthew 7:15, 24:11, 24, Mark 13:22, Acts 13:6, 2 Peter 2:1, 3:3, 1 John 4:1]
- ☆ The last False Prophet who comes in partnership with the Antichrist finds his destiny to be the eternal Lake of Fire along side of the Antichrist. [Revelation 13:1-18, 19:20-21]
