19 "You shall not charge interest to your brother--interest on money or food or anything that is lent out at interest. 20 To a foreigner you may charge interest, but to your brother you shall not charge interest, that the LORD your God may bless you in all to which you set your hand in the land which you are entering to possess. NKJV

## Facts Revealed:

- ❖ You shall not charge your brother interest on money, food, or anything that might be lent out at interest. [Deuteronomy 23:19-20, Exodus 22:25, Leviticus 25:35-37]
- **♦** You may charge interest to a foreigner.
- ❖ You may not charge interest to your brother.
- ☼ To obey this command may result in a blessing from Yehowah Eloheyk (the Lord your God) in the land you are entering to possess, in all that you set your hand to do.
