Deuteronomy 4:41-43 Cities of Refuge appointed by Moses East of Jordan River

⁴¹ Then Moses set apart three cities on this side of the Jordan, toward the rising of the sun, ⁴² that the manslayer might flee there, who kills his neighbor unintentionally, without having hated him in time past, and that by fleeing to one of these cities he might live: ⁴³ Bezer in the wilderness on the plateau for the Reubenites, Ramoth in Gilead for the Gadites, and Golan in Bashan for the Manassites. NKJV

Facts Revealed:

- ☆ Moses appointed three cities east of the Jordan River as Cities of Refuge:
 - \Rightarrow **Bezer** in the wilderness on the plateau for the Reubenites. (Plateau location of Bezer is uncertain).

 - ♦ Golan in Bashan for the Manassites. (East of the Sea of Galilee)
