## Fear God, Keep Your Vows

<sup>1.</sup>Walk prudently when you go to Beit Elohiym (the house of God); and draw near to hear rather than to give the sacrifice of fools, for they do not know that they do evil.

 $^{2}$  Do not be rash with your mouth, And let not your heart utter anything hastily before Elohiym (God). For Elohiym (God) *is* in heaven, and you on earth; Therefore let your words be few.

<sup>3</sup> For a dream comes through much activity, And a fool's voice *is known* by *his* many words.

 $^4$  When you make a vow to Elohiym (God), do not delay to pay it; For He has no pleasure in fools. Pay what you have vowed -

- ✤ It is both wise and demonstrates your reverence toward God to keep your prayers concise and to the point with few words, lest you prove yourself to be a fool.

Better not to vow than to vow and not pay. [Ecclesiastes 5:4-5]

☆ This agrees with the instructions Moses delivered to the people of Israel, "This *is* the thing which Yahweh (the LORD) has commanded: If a man makes a vow to Yahweh (the LORD),

or swears an oath to bind himself by some agreement, he shall not break his word; he shall do according to all that proceeds out of his mouth. " [Numbers 30:1-2]

- ☆ "When you make a vow to Yahweh Eloheyka (the Lord your God), you shall not delay to pay it; for Yahweh Eloheyka (the Lord your God) will surely require it of you, and it would be sin to you." [Deuteronomy 23:21]
- Do not let your mouth cause your flesh to sin, nor say before the messenger of God that it was an error. Why should Elohiym (God) be angry at your excuse\* and destroy the work of your hands?

For in the multitude of dreams and many words *there is* also vanity. But fear Elohiym (God). [Ecclesiastes 5:6-7]

- ✤ Elohiym knows your thoughts before you think them and hears your words before you say them, He also knows the motives of your heart for your words or actions.

- $\diamond$  Solomon saw the many words of the fool and heathen as vanity.
- $\diamond$  He wisely advised that you fear Elohiym.
