## Exodus 25:31-40 Golden Lampstand

31 "You shall also make a lampstand of pure gold; the lampstand shall be of hammered work. Its shaft, its branches, its bowls, its ornamental knobs, and flowers shall be of one piece. 32 And six branches shall come out of its sides: three branches of the lampstand out of one side, and three branches of the lampstand out of the other side. 33 Three bowls shall be made like almond blossoms on one branch, with an ornamental knob and a flower, and three bowls made like almond blossoms on the other branch, with an ornamental knob and a flower--and so for the six branches that come out of the lampstand. 34 On the lampstand itself four bowls shall be made like almond blossoms, each with its ornamental knob and flower. 35 And there shall be a knob under the first two branches of the same, a knob under the second two branches of the same, and a knob under the third two branches of the same, according to the six branches that extend from the lampstand. 36 Their knobs and their branches shall be of one piece; all of it shall be one hammered piece of pure gold.

37 You shall make seven lamps for it, and they shall arrange its lamps so that they give light in front of it. 38 And its wick-trimmers and their trays shall be of pure gold. 39 It shall be made of a talent of pure gold, with all these utensils. 40 And see to it that you make them according to the pattern which was shown you on the mountain. NKJV

## Facts Revealed:

- **☼** The Lampstand is made out of a talent of pure gold, all one piece of hammered work.
- **♦** The gold symbolizes divinity, it is divine throughout.
- ➡ The hammered work symbolizes the hammering of God's judgment as Jesus, God's Savior of
  the world, took our punishment for our sins upon Himself as He went to the cross at Calvary
  bearing the sins of the world on His shoulders.
- ☼ The knops and flowers symbolize God's grace provided for mankind as Jesus came as the Light of the World.
- ➡ The seven lamps represent the Seven Spirits of God which speaks of the seven manifestations of the Holy Spirit at work in the lives of His Saints, these Seven Spirits are sent throughout the world. [Revelation 5:6]
- The Seven Spirits of God are seen as the seven lamps before the throne of God in Heaven as witnessed by John when he was caught up to the Throne of God in Heaven. [Revelation 1:4, 4:5] And by Zechariah as he was shown the Lampstand in his vision as God spoke of the power of the Spirit of God. [Zechariah 4:1-6, 4:10],
- Again we are reminded that all the articles of the Tabernacle in the Wilderness are made as a copy of what formerly existed with God in Heaven, and Moses was commanded to be careful to make them exactly according to the pattern he was shown on the Mountain, where he had a glimpse of the setting in Heaven. [Exodus 25:40]
- The Seven Spirits of God are before the Throne of God in Heaven and dispatched by the Lamb of God throughout the whole earth to do their work in the affairs of God's Saints. 
   [Revelation 1:4, 3:7, 4:5, and 5:6]
- These Seven Spirits are also called the Seven Eyes of Yehowah Who run to and fro through the whole earth. [Zechariah 3:9, 4:1-10, Revelation 5:6]
