## Exodus 28:2-4 **Priesthood Holy Garments**

- 2 And you shall make holy garments for Aaron your brother, for glory and for beauty.
- <sup>3</sup> So you shall speak to all who are gifted artisans, whom I have filled with the spirit of wisdom, that they may make Aaron's garments, to consecrate him, that he may minister to Me as priest.
- 4 And these are the garments which they shall make: a breastplate, an ephod, a robe, a skillfully woven tunic, a turban, and a sash. So they shall make holy garments for Aaron your brother and his sons, that he may minister to Me as priest. NKJV

- **☼** The Holy Garments are for glory and for beauty.
  - ♦ All things Holy are beautiful and speak of the Glory that resides in the presence of God.
  - ♦ It speaks of how gloriously beautiful to God and to man is the one who is faithful in his service toward the Most High God of all. [Isaiah 4:2, 52:7, Romans 10:15]
  - ♦ It points forward to the time of the Kingdom of God when Messiah will sit on the throne in Zion and the place of his feet will be glorious. [Isaiah 60:13, 4:2, 11:10, 63:1, Exodus 15:6, 11, Psalm 111:2-3]
  - ♦ It speaks of the beauty of praise of the upright. [Psalm 33:1, 147:1, 62:2]
- **☼** They are for Aaron to consecrate him (set him apart), that He may minister to God as priest.
- **☼** They are for Aaron, and for his sons.
  - ❖ The Glory garments are for the High Priest, while the other garments are for all the priests the sons of Aaron.
- ⇒ They are to be made by gifted artisans whom God has filled with the Spirit of Wisdom enabling them to make them perfectly.
  - ♦ The gifting by the Holy Spirit has always been and always will be for those who are fulfilling a service for God and need the special giftings enabling them to fulfill the special task required.
