## Exodus 28:39-43 **Linen Clothing** – for the Priests

- <sup>39</sup> "You shall skillfully weave the tunic of fine linen thread, you shall make the turban of fine linen, and you shall make the sash of woven work.
- <sup>40</sup> "For Aaron's sons you shall make tunics, and you shall make sashes for them. And you shall make hats for them, for glory and beauty.
- 41 So you shall put them on Aaron your brother and on his sons with him. You shall anoint them, consecrate them, and sanctify them, that they may minister to Me as priests.
- 42 And you shall make for them linen trousers to cover their nakedness; they shall reach from the waist to the thighs. 43 They shall be on Aaron and on his sons when they come into the tabernacle of meeting, or when they come near the altar to minister in the holy place, that they do not incur iniquity and die. It shall be a statute forever to him and his descendants after him. NKJV

## Facts Revealed:

- **☼** The linen clothing for Aaron include:
  - ♦ Coat (Tunic)
  - ♦ Mitre (bonnet, turban) mitsnepheth
  - ♦ Sash (girdle, belt)
  - ♦ Trousers (under garments, breeches)
- **☼** The linen clothing for Aaron's sons include:
  - ♦ Coat (Tunic)
  - ♦ Hat (bonnet, turban, head-gear, cap, head-band, head-tires) migba` ah
  - ♦ Sash (girdle, belt)
  - ❖ Trousers (under garments, breeches)
- **☼** The Priest's clothing is for glory and beauty.
- **☼** The Priests are to be anointed and consecrated in them.
- **☼** They are to be worn when they enter the Tabernacle of meeting, or when they approach the altar to minister in the Holy Place.
- **⋄** Failure to obey this requirement is counted as iniquity and caries the death penalty.
- **♦** The statute is continual forever.
