³⁴ And the LORD said to Moses: "Take sweet spices, stacte and onycha and galbanum, and pure frankincense with these sweet spices; there shall be equal amounts of each. ³⁵ You shall make of these an incense, a compound according to the art of the perfumer, salted, pure, and holy. ³⁶ And you shall beat some of it very fine, and put some of it before the Testimony in the tabernacle of meeting where I will meet with you. It shall be most holy to you.

³⁷ But as for the incense which you shall make, you shall not make any for yourselves, according to its composition. It shall be to you holy for the LORD. ³⁸ Whoever makes any like it, to smell it, he shall be cut off from his people." NKJV

 - ☆ It represents Jesus the Messiah Whom God sent from Heaven to be the Mediator between God and man. [1 Timothy 2:5, Hebrews 8:6, 9:14-15, 12:24]
 - ♦ The Incense is a Salted, Pure, and Holy mixture. It is not to be duplicated.
 - \diamond To make anything similar for personal use bears the Death Penalty.
