Exodus 36:35-38 Veil and Door made

³⁵ And he made a veil of blue, purple, and scarlet thread, and fine worked linen; it was woven with an artistic design of cherubim. ³⁶ He made for it four pillars of acacia wood, and overlaid them with gold, with their hooks of gold; and he cast four sockets of silver for them. [Exodus 26:31-32]

³⁷ He also made a screen for the tabernacle door, of blue , purple, and scarlet thread, and fine woven linen, made by a weaver, ³⁸ and its five pillars with their hooks. And he overlaid their capitals and their rings with gold, but their five sockets were bronze. NKJV [Exodus 26:36-37]

Facts Revealed:

The Veil

- ☆ The Linen Veil is made the same as the innermost Linen covering of the Tabernacle and they both represent the Throne Room of Heaven where the presence of God resides.
 - \diamond Both are made of fine twisted linen, blue, purple, and scarlet yarn.
 - ♦ Both are woven with an intricate design of Cherubim by an artistic craftsman, which is called "Cunning Work" in the Authorized King James version, and indicates a design which appears the same on both sides of the veil or of the linen covering. It must be perfect on both sides.
 - ☆ Living Cherubim were found in the Bible first at the east end of the Garden of Eden after Adam and Eve were driven from the garden to the East, these Cherubim were with the flaming sword guarding the way to the Tree of Life. [Genesis 3:24]
 - ☆ The second appearance of living Cherubim is found in the vision of God that was shown to Ezekiel and described in [Ezekiel chapter 10].
 - ☆ All other Bible references to Cherubim are found in the design of the Tabernacle in the Wilderness, and of the Temple which was first built by Solomon. These are mentioned in the Bible books of [Exodus, Numbers, 1 Samuel, 2 Samuel, 1 Kings, 2 Kings, 1 Chronicles, 2 Chronicles, Psalms, Isaiah, Ezekiel, and Hebrews]
- ☆ The Veil is supported on gold covered pillars, by gold hooks, and gold clasps, representing Divinity.
- ☆ The pillars are separated from the sand of the earth by Silver Sockets which represent our Redemption provided by God.
- ☆ The Veil is placed as a separation between the Most Holy Place where God resides, from the Holy Place where the Priests may enter to perform their work in the service of God.
- ☆ The only thing placed in the Most Holy Place, is the Ark of the Testimony containing the Stone Tablets of the commandments of God written by the finger of God Himself, and covered by the solid gold Mercy Seat, from which God will meet with Moses and give His instructions to the Children of Israel.
 - This represents the personal presence and authority of El Shaday (the Almighty God of Creation), Yehowah Elohey Yisrael (the Lord God of Israel).
- ☆ In the Holy Place on the outside or east of the Veil, are the other articles of furniture, which are the Gold covered Table of Showbread on the right side toward the north as you view from the east, and the solid Gold Lampstand on the left side toward the south.

The Door

☆ The East and only entrance to the Tabernacle is for the Priests to enter to do the service of God in the Holy Place.

- ☆ The screen for the door is much heavier fabric woven of blue, purple, and scarlet yarn, and fine twisted linen.
- \diamond It is made by a weaver.
- ☆ The Screen is supported on Gold covered Pillars by hooks of gold. It too is supported by divinity.
- ☆ The pillars are separated from the sand of the earth by Bronze or copper sockets which represent the judgment of God Most High.

Blue - represents the color of Heaven.
Purple - represents Royalty
Scarlet - represent Sinful man.
Fine twisted Linen - represent Righteousness.

All of these materials speak of Jesus our Messiah:

Who came down from Heaven (**blue**). [John 3:13, 6:33, 1 Corinthians 15:47, 1 Thessalonians 4:16] Who is the King of kings and Lord of lords (royalty **purple**). [1 Timothy 6:15, Revelation 17:14, 19:16] Who took our sins (**scarlet**) upon Himself for our Salvation. [1 Peter 2:24, 2 Corinthians 5:21] And Who imputes to us His Righteousness (**fine twisted linen**). [Romans 4:1-11, 5:17, 2 Corinthians 5:21, Philippians 3:8-9]

He is the one who became man (wood), and retained His divinity (Gold). [John 1:1-2, 14, 33-34, Philippians 2:5-11]

He paid the price for our Redemption (silver) [Ephesians 1:7, Colossians 1:14, Titus 2:13-14]

He will exercise God's judgment (bronze or copper). [John 5:21-22, 25-27, Romans 14:10, 2 Corinthians 5:10, Jude 14-15]

This all speaks of God's doing and it is marvelous in our eyes. HalleluYAH!
