## Exodus 36:8-19

8 Then all the gifted artisans among them who worked on the tabernacle made ten curtains woven of fine linen, and of blue, purple and, scarlet thread; with artistic designs of cherubim they made them. 9 The length of each curtain was twenty-eight cubits, and the width of each curtain four cubits; the curtains were all the same size. 10 And he coupled five curtains to one another, and the other five curtains he coupled to one another. 11 He made loops of blue yarn on the edge of the curtain on the selvedge of one set; likewise he did on the outer edge of the other curtain of the second set. 12 Fifty loops he made on one curtain, and fifty loops he made on the edge of the curtain on the end of the second set; the loops held one curtain to another. 13 And he made fifty clasps of gold, and coupled the curtains to one another with the clasps, that it might be one tabernacle. [Exodus 26:1-6]

14 He made curtains of goats' hair for the tent over the tabernacle; he made eleven curtains. 15 The length of each curtain was thirty cubits, and the width of each curtain four cubits; the eleven curtains were the same size. 16 He coupled five curtains by themselves and six curtains by themselves. 17 And he made fifty loops on the edge of the curtain that is outermost in one set, and fifty loops he made on the edge of the curtain of the second set. 18 He also made fifty bronze clasps to couple the tent together, that it might be one. [Exodus 26:7-13]

19 Then he made a covering for the tent of ram skins dyed red, and a covering of badger skins above that. NKJV [Exodus 26:14]

## Facts Revealed:

- Since God starts with Himself, the linen covering represents the throne room of the presence of God.
- **☼** The goats hair curtain represent the darkness of human sin.
- ☼ The ram skins died red represent the Blood of Christ that covers the sin of those who are believers who are God's people.
- **♦** The badger skins represent the world around us and its influence on us.
- **♦** All of this speaks of God's plan of Salvation in Christ:
  - ♦ He Who came into the world as a man to be exposed to the world and all its influences. He was tempted in all points yet remained without sin. [Hebrews 4:15]
  - ♦ He died on the cross to provide the covering for our sins, [Romans 4:7, James 5:20, Matthew 26:28, Ephesians 1:17, Colossians 1:14, Hebrews 9:11-28, John 1:7, Revelation 1:5]
  - ♦ He took our sins upon Himself on the cross, [1 Peter 2:24, 2 Corinthians 5:21]
  - ♦ He returned to the presence of God in Heaven to forever be with God, and then to take His place as the temple and light of the New Heaven and the New earth, and New Jerusalem. [Hebrews 1:3, Acts 2:33, 7:55, Ephesians 1:20, 1 Peter 3:22, Revelation 21:22-23]

**Blue** - represents the color of Heaven.

**Purple** - represents Royalty

**Scarlet** – represent Sinful man.

Fine twisted Linen – represent Righteousness.
