Exodus 39:27-31 **Tunics, turban, sashes, hats, and trousers, for Aaron and his sons** 27 They made tunics, artistically woven of fine linen, for Aaron and his sons, 28 a turban of fine linen, exquisite hats of fine linen, short trousers of fine woven linen, 29 and a sash of fine woven linen with blue, purple, and scarlet thread, made by a weaver, as the LORD had commanded Moses.

Plate, Holiness to Yehowah

30 Then they made the plate of the holy crown of pure gold, and wrote on it an inscription like the engraving of a signet: HOLINESS TO THE LORD. 31 And they tied to it a blue cord, to fasten it above on the turban, as the LORD had commanded Moses. NKJV [Exodus 28:39-43]

 - ♦ Coat (Tunic)
 - ♦ Mitre (bonnet, turban) mitsnepheth
 - ♦ Sash (girdle, belt)
 - ❖ Trousers (under garments, breeches)
- **☼** The linen clothing for Aaron's sons include:
 - ♦ Coat (Tunic)
 - ♦ Hat (bonnet, turban, head-gear, cap, head-band, head-tires) migba` ah
 - ♦ Sash (girdle, belt)
 - ♦ Trousers (under garments, breeches)
- **☼** The Priest's clothing is for glory and beauty.
- **☼** The Priests are to be anointed and consecrated in them.
- **☼** They are to be worn when they enter the Tabernacle of meeting, or when they approach the altar to minister in the Holy Place.
- **☼** Failure to obey this requirement is counted as iniquity and caries the death penalty. [Exodus 28:43]
- **☼** The statute is continual forever.
