Mother a Lioness

¹ "Moreover take up a lamentation for the princes of Israel, ² and say:

'What is your mother?

A lioness: She lay down among the lions; Among the young lions she nourished her cubs.

- ³ She brought up one of her cubs, And he became a young lion; He learned to catch prey, And he devoured men.
- ⁴ The nations also heard of him; He was trapped in their pit, And they brought him with chains to the land of Egypt.
- ⁵ 'When she saw that she waited, that her hope was lost, She took another of her cubs and made him a young lion.
- ⁶ He roved among the lions, And became a young lion; He learned to catch prey; He devoured men.
- ⁷ He knew their desolate places, And laid waste their cities; The land with its fullness was desolated By the noise of his roaring.
- 8 Then the nations set against him from the provinces on every side, And spread their net over him; He was trapped in their pit.
- 9 They put him in a cage with chains, And brought him to the king of Babylon; They brought him in nets, That his voice should no longer be heard on the mountains of Israel.

Mother a Vine

- ¹⁰ 'Your mother was like a vine in your bloodline, Planted by the waters, Fruitful and full of branches Because of many waters.
- 11 She had strong branches for scepters of rulers. She towered in stature above the thick branches, And was seen in her height amid the dense foliage.
- 12 But she was plucked up in fury, She was cast down to the ground, And the east wind dried her fruit. Her strong branches were broken and withered; The fire consumed them.
- 13 And now she is planted in the wilderness, In a dry and thirsty land.
- 14 Fire has come out from a rod of her branches And devoured her fruit, So that she has no strong branch a scepter for ruling.'"
