## Ezekiel 29:1-21 **Egypt – Babylonians payment for work against Tyre. Forty year desolation**

## Proclamation Against Egypt

- 1 In the tenth year, in the tenth month, on the twelfth day of the month, the word of Yahweh (the Lord) came to me, saying,
- <sup>2</sup> "Son of man, set your face against Pharaoh king of Egypt, and prophesy against him, and against all Egypt.
- 3 Speak, and say, 'Thus says Adoney Yahweh (the Lord God):
- "Behold, I am against you, O Pharaoh king of Egypt, O great monster who lies in the midst of his rivers, Who has said, 'My River is my own; I have made it for myself.'
- <sup>4</sup> But I will put hooks in your jaws, And cause the fish of your rivers to stick to your scales; I will bring you up out of the midst of your rivers, And all the fish in your rivers will stick to your scales.
- <sup>5</sup> I will leave you in the wilderness, You and all the fish of your rivers; You shall fall on the open field; You shall not be picked up or gathered. I have given you as food To the beasts of the field And to the birds of the heavens.
- <sup>6</sup> "Then all the inhabitants of Egypt Shall know that I am Yahweh (the Lord), Because they have been a staff of reed to the house of Israel.
- <sup>7</sup> When they took hold of you with the hand, You broke and tore all their shoulders; When they leaned on you, You broke and made all their backs quiver."
- 8 'Therefore thus says Adoney Yahweh (the Lord God): "Surely I will bring a sword upon you and cut off from you man and beast.
- 9 And the land of Egypt shall become desolate and waste; then they will know that I am Yahweh (the Lord), because he said, 'The River is mine, and I have made it.'
- 10 Indeed, therefore, I am against you and against your rivers, and I will make the land of Egypt utterly waste and desolate, from Migdol to Syene, as far as the border of Ethiopia.
- 11 Neither foot of man shall pass through it nor foot of beast pass through it, and it shall be uninhabited forty years.
- 12 I will make the land of Egypt desolate in the midst of the countries that are desolate; and among the cities that are laid waste, her cities shall be desolate forty years; and I will scatter the Egyptians among the nations and disperse them throughout the countries."
- 13 'Yet, thus says Adoney Yahweh (the Lord God): "At the end of forty years I will gather the Egyptians from the peoples among whom they were scattered.
- 14 I will bring back the captives of Egypt and cause them to return to the land of Pathros, to the land of their origin, and there they shall be a lowly kingdom.
- 15 It shall be the lowliest of kingdoms; it shall never again exalt itself above the nations, for I will diminish them so that they will not rule over the nations anymore.
- 16 No longer shall it be the confidence of the house of Israel, but will remind them of their iniquity when they turned to follow them. Then they shall know that I am Adoney Yahweh (the Lord God).""

## Babylonia Will Plunder Egypt

17 And it came to pass in the twenty-seventh year, in the first month, on the first day of the month, that the word of Yahweh (the Lord) came to me, saying,

- 18 "Son of man, Nebuchadnezzar king of Babylon caused his army to labor strenuously against Tyre; every head was made bald, and every shoulder rubbed raw; yet neither he nor his army received wages from Tyre, for the labor which they expended on it.
- 19 Therefore thus says Adoney Yahweh (the Lord God): 'Surely I will give the land of Egypt to Nebuchadnezzar king of Babylon; he shall take away her wealth, carry off her spoil, and remove her pillage; and that will be the wages for his army.
- <sup>20</sup> I have given him the land of Egypt for his labor, because they worked for Me,' says Adoney Yahweh (the Lord God).
- <sup>21</sup> 'In that day I will cause the horn of the house of Israel to spring forth, and I will open your mouth to speak in their midst. Then they shall know that I am Yahweh (the Lord).'"

## Facts Revealed:

Proclamation Against Egypt [Ezekiel 29:1-16]

- ☼ The message came from Yahweh to Ezekiel on the twelfth day of the tenth month of the tenth year of Ezekiel's captivity.
  - ♦ The message is against Pharaoh king of Egypt.
  - ♦ Pharaoh is compared to a great monster in the rivers of Egypt and the people of Egypt to the fish in the rivers.
  - ♦ Pharaoh and his people will fall on the open fields and become food for the birds and beasts
  - ♦ On that day the inhabitants of Egypt will know that Yahweh is the true living God.
  - ❖ Israel turned to Egypt for help in their time of trouble, but to no avail, Egypt failed like a broken reed.
  - ♦ Yahweh will cut off both man and beast, leaving the land of Egypt desolate and waste for forty years because of their pride and arrogance against Yahweh's people Israel.
  - ♦ At the end of forty years Yahweh will restore the remnant of the people of Egypt to their land as a lowliest of kingdoms.
  - ❖ Israel will no longer turn to Egypt for help, but Egypt will be a reminder to Israel of their iniquity when Israel turned to them for help.
  - **♦** Then they will know that Adoney Yahweh is the Lord God.

Babylonia Will Plunder Egypt [Ezekiel 29:17-21]

- ★ The first day of the first month of the twenty-seventh year of Ezekiel's captivity the message from Yahweh came to Ezekiel.

  - ❖ 'In that day I will cause the horn of the house of Israel to spring forth, and I will open Ezekiel's mouth to speak in their midst. (Ezekiel had been mute except when Yahweh gave him a message for the people of Israel. [Ezekiel 3:26-27]
  - ♦ Then they shall know that I am Yahweh (the Lord)."
