Judgment on Israel Is at hand – The End Has Come

- 1 Moreover the word of Yahweh (the Lord) came to me, saying, 2 "And you, son of man, thus says Adoney Yahweh (the Lord God) to the land of Israel:
- 'An end! The end has come upon the four corners of the land.
- ³ Now the end has come upon you, And I will send My anger against you; I will judge you according to your ways, And I will repay you for all your abominations.
- 4 My eye will not spare you, Nor will I have pity; But I will repay your ways, And your abominations will be in your midst; Then you shall know that I am Yahweh (the Lord)!'
- 5 "Thus says Adoney Yahweh (the Lord God):
- 'A disaster, a singular disaster; Behold, it has come!
- 6 An end has come, The end has come; It has dawned for you; Behold, it has come!
- ⁷ Doom has come to you, you who dwell in the land; The time has come, A day of trouble is near, And not of rejoicing in the mountains.
- 8 Now upon you I will soon pour out My fury, And spend My anger upon you; I will judge you according to your ways, And I will repay you for all your abominations.
- 9 'My eye will not spare, Nor will I have pity; I will repay you according to your ways, And your abominations will be in your midst. Then you shall know that I am Yahweh (the Lord) who strikes.

Wickedness and Violence has come to full maturity

- ¹⁰ 'Behold, the day! Behold, it has come! Doom has gone out; The rod has blossomed, Pride has budded.
- Violence has risen up into a rod of wickedness; None of them shall remain, None of their multitude, None of them; Nor shall there be wailing for them.
- 12 The time has come, The day draws near.
- 'Let not the buyer rejoice, Nor the seller mourn, For wrath is on their whole multitude.
- 13 For the seller shall not return to what has been sold, Though he may still be alive; For the vision concerns the whole multitude, And it shall not turn back; No one will strengthen himself Who lives in iniquity.

The warning has been sounded

- ¹⁴ They have blown the trumpet and made everyone ready, But no one goes to battle; For My wrath is on all their multitude.
- 15 The sword is outside, And the pestilence and famine within. Whoever is in the field Will die by the sword; And whoever is in the city, Famine and pestilence will devour him.

A humble small remnant will escape – Idolatry will be abhorred

- ¹⁶ Those who survive will escape and be on the mountains Like doves of the valleys, All of them mourning, Each for his iniquity.
- 17 Every hand will be feeble, And every knee will be as weak as water.
- 18 They will also be girded with sackcloth; Horror will cover them; Shame will be on every face, Baldness on all their heads.

19 'They will throw their silver into the streets, And their gold will be like refuse; Their silver and their gold will not be able to deliver them In the day of the wrath of Yahweh (the Lord); They will not satisfy their souls, Nor fill their stomachs, Because it became their stumbling block of iniquity.

Consequence of Abominable Idolatry and violence

- ²⁰ 'As for the beauty of his ornaments, He set it in majesty; But they made from it The images of their abominations Their detestable things; Therefore I have made it Like refuse to them.
- 21 I will give it as plunder Into the hands of strangers, And to the wicked of the earth as spoil; And they shall defile it.
- 22 I will turn My face from them, And they will defile My secret place; For robbers shall enter it and defile it.
- 23 'Make a chain, For the land is filled with crimes of blood, And the city is full of violence.
- 24 Therefore I will bring the worst of the Gentiles, And they will possess their houses; I will cause the pomp of the strong to cease, And their holy places shall be defiled.
- 25 Destruction comes; They will seek peace, but there shall be none.
- ²⁶ Disaster will come upon disaster, And rumor will be upon rumor. Then they will seek a vision from a prophet; But the law will perish from the priest, And counsel from the elders.
- ²⁷ 'The king will mourn, The prince will be clothed with desolation, And the hands of the common people will tremble. I will do to them according to their way, And according to what they deserve I will judge them; Then they shall know that I am Yahweh (the Lord)!''' NKJV

Facts Revealed:

- - ♦ When the time for judgment comes, Yahweh gives clear detailed warning to provide a chance for the people to repent and avoid it.
 - ♦ Yahweh's Judgment is complete and final without pity because He has been faithful to give plenty of warnings through His prophets, only to be rejected.
 - ♦ Belligerent arrogant wickedness cannot go fully unpunished, but reflects the righteous Wrath of God.
 - ♦ The punishment is appropriate to the offense and comes in the fullness of time.
 - ❖ The purpose of the punishment is to remind the people that Yahweh is the true and living God over all His creation.
- ♦ Wickedness and Violence has come to full maturity [Ezekiel 7:10-13]
 - ♦ Yahweh has appointed a day of Judgment.
 - ♦ The iniquity of the people is allowed to reach its complete fullness before Yahweh pours out His Wrath on the people. [Genesis 15:16]
 - ♦ The punishment will impact all the people.
 - ♦ When the punishment has begun, no-one will be able to hinder it.
- ★ The warning has been sounded [Ezekiel 7:14-15]
 - ♦ The alarm has been sounded, but the people have ignored it.
 - ♦ Yahweh described the distress of the land under siege.
 - ♦ The Wrath is against all the multitude of people.
- ♦ A humble small remnant will escape Idolatry will be abhorred [Ezekiel 7:16-18]
 - ♦ The ones who escape will be like doves on the mountains, each mourning for his iniquity.
 - ♦ They will experience weakness, horror and shame.

- ❖ Their idolatry will not satisfy them but will seem repulsive to them because it was their stumbling block of iniquity.
- ❖ Consequence of Abominable Idolatry and violence [Ezekiel 7:20-27]
 - ♦ Yahweh had given His people prosperity beauty and ornaments of Majesty.
 - ♦ But they had made from it images of their abominations, detestable things.
 - ♦ Yahweh has made their idolatry like refuse to them.
 - ♦ He has given it as plunder to their enemies to be defiled.
 - ♦ Yahweh has turned His face away and His holy things will be spoil for the enemy who will
 defile it.
 - ♦ Because the land has been filled with crimes of blood shed and violence.
 - ♦ The worst of the Gentiles will possess their houses.
 - ♦ The people will seek peace but will find none.
 - ♦ Disaster will come upon the king, princes, prophets, priests, elders and the people.
 - ♦ Yahweh will judge them according to their ways.
 - ♦ The purpose is that they will know that Yahweh has done it just as He said He would.
