

Ezekiel 8:1-18 **Abominations in Temple of Yahweh in Jerusalem**

Yahweh transported Ezekiel to Jerusalem to see all the Abominations done in the Temple

1 And it came to pass in the sixth year, in the sixth month, on the fifth day of the month, as I sat in my house with the elders of Judah sitting before me, that the hand of Adoney Yahweh (the Lord God) fell upon me there.

2 Then I looked, and there was a likeness, like the appearance of fire — from the appearance of His waist and downward, fire; and from His waist and upward, like the appearance of brightness, like the color of amber.

3 He stretched out the form of a hand, and took me by a lock of my hair; and the Spirit lifted me up between earth and heaven, and brought me in visions of Elohiym (God) to Jerusalem, to the door of the north gate of the inner court, where the seat of the image of jealousy was, which provokes to jealousy.

4 And behold, the glory of Elohey Yisrael (the God of Israel) was there, like the vision that I saw in the plain.

5 Then He said to me, "Son of man, lift your eyes now toward the north." So I lifted my eyes toward the north, and there, north of the altar gate, was this image of jealousy in the entrance.

6 Furthermore He said to me, "Son of man, do you see what they are doing, the great abominations that the house of Israel commits here, to make Me go far away from My sanctuary? Now turn again, you will see greater abominations."

7 So He brought me to the door of the court; and when I looked, there was a hole in the wall.

8 Then He said to me, "Son of man, dig into the wall"; and when I dug into the wall, there was a door.

9 And He said to me, "Go in, and see the wicked abominations which they are doing there."

10 So I went in and saw, and there — every sort of creeping thing, abominable beasts, and all the idols of the house of Israel, portrayed all around on the walls.

11 And there stood before them seventy men of the elders of the house of Israel, and in their midst stood Jaazaniah the son of Shaphan. Each man had a censer in his hand, and a thick cloud of incense went up.

12 Then He said to me, "Son of man, have you seen what the elders of the house of Israel do in the dark, every man in the room of his idols? For they say, 'Yahweh (The Lord) does not see us, Yahweh (the Lord) has forsaken the land.'"

13 And He said to me, "Turn again, and you will see greater abominations that they are doing."

14 So He brought me to the door of the north gate of Beit Yahweh (the Lord's house); and to my dismay, women were sitting there weeping for Tammuz.

15 Then He said to me, "Have you seen this, O son of man? Turn again, you will see greater abominations than these."

16 So He brought me into the inner court of Beit Yahweh (the Lord's house); and there, at the door of the temple of Yahweh (the Lord), between the porch and the altar, were about twenty-five men with their backs toward the temple of Yahweh (the Lord) and their faces toward the east, and they were worshiping the sun toward the east.

17 And He said to me, "Have you seen this, O son of man? Is it a trivial thing to the house of Judah to commit the abominations which they commit here? For they have filled the land with violence; then they have returned to provoke Me to anger. Indeed they put the branch to their nose.

18 Therefore I also will act in fury. My eye will not spare nor will I have pity; and though they cry in My ears with a loud voice, I will not hear them."

Facts Revealed:

Yahweh transported Ezekiel to Jerusalem to witness all the Abominations done in the Temple

- ✧ And it came to pass in the sixth year, in the sixth month, on the fifth day of the month, as I sat in my house with the elders of Judah sitting before me, that the hand of Adoney Yahweh (the Lord God) fell upon me there. [Ezekiel 8:1]
- ✧ The timing of this vision came to Ezekiel on the fifth day of the sixth month of the sixth year after he was carried away from Jerusalem into captivity by the Babylonian forces.
- ✧ Yahweh had made Ezekiel mute and unable to speak until he received a message from the Lord, then He opened Ezekiel's mouth so he could give the message to the people in captivity. [Ezekiel 3:26-27]
- ✧ The elders of Israel in captivity apparently spent much time sitting with Ezekiel waiting for a word from Yahweh. [Ezekiel 8:1]
- ✧ Ezekiel saw a vision of God like the vision he saw in the plain. Yahweh took Ezekiel by a lock of his hair and Ezekiel was carried by the Spirit to the Temple in Jerusalem to see what was going on there so he could understand Yahweh's reason for Judging the people. [Ezekiel 8:2-3]
- ✧ The Glory of Yahweh was there. [Ezekiel 8:4]
- ✧ Yahweh showed Ezekiel all the abominable things that were being done in the Temple of Yahweh, the perversions and idolatry filled the Temple out of the sight of the common people. [Ezekiel 8:5-16]
- ✧ And the idolaters thought Yahweh could not see what they were doing. [Ezekiel 8:12]
- ✧ Yahweh sees and knows what we do in secret, and will judge us all according to what we have done whether good or evil. [Ecclesiastes 12:14, Daniel 2:21, Hosea 12:2, Zechariah 1:6, Matthew 16:27, Luke 8:17, Romans 2:5-6, 2 Corinthians 5:10, Revelation 2:23, Jude 1:14-15, Revelation 22:12]
- ✧ Yahweh takes their abominations very seriously.
- ✧ The branch to the nose seems to represent a practice associated with idolatry.
- ✧ Along with their idolatry and abominations done in secret, the land has been filled with violence. [Ezekiel 8:17]
- ✧ All of this works together to arouse the Wrath of Yahweh.
- ✧ When the time for Judgment comes, Yahweh will act in righteousness without pity and He will not listen to the cries of anguish from blatant arrogant sinners.
- ✧ This is a call for all to seriously consider where our attitude and behavior will take us in the end. [Deuteronomy 32:29]
