Genesis 4:25-26 **Seth and Enosh Born and Prayer Began**

25 And Adam knew his wife again, and she bore a son and named him Seth, "For God has appointed another seed for me instead of Abel, whom Cain killed." 26 And as for Seth, to him also a son was born; and he named him Enosh. Then men began to call on the name of the LORD. NKJV

Facts revealed:

- Eve's **second** conception produced Seth; and Eve recognized that it was Elohiym (God) Who made it possible and claimed Seth as the replacement for Abel, whom Cain killed. This happened 130 years <u>after</u> creation of Adam. [Genesis 5:1-3]
- ❖ Seth also had a son and he named him Enosh. At first glance it appears that it happened immediately, but a look at [Genesis 5:1-6] shows that it was after he reached the age of 105.
- So it was at least 235 years *after* creation that men began to "call on the Name of Yahowah (the Lord)."
