Assyria Destroyed

²⁴ The Lord of hosts has sworn, saying, "Surely, as I have thought, so it shall come to pass, And as I have purposed, so it shall stand:

²⁵ That I will break the Assyrian in My land, And on My mountains tread him underfoot. Then his yoke shall be removed from them, And his burden removed from their shoulders.

²⁶ This is the purpose that is purposed against the whole earth, And this is the hand that is stretched out over all the nations.

27 For the Lord of hosts has purposed, And who will annul it? His hand is stretched out, And who will turn it back?"

Philistia Destroyed

28 This is the burden which came in the year that King Ahaz died.

Facts Revealed:

Assyria Destroyed [Isaiah 14:24-27]

- As Yahweh Tsebavta (the Lord of hosts) has purposed, so it shall be done.
 - ♦ God's purpose is to destroy the nations of the whole earth, this will be accomplished at the time of the Great Tribulation.
 - ♦ Assyria is specifically named among them.

Philistia Destroyed [Isaiah 14:28-32]

This is an End-Time message concerning the people who dwell in the land of the Philistines.

- The message came the year that Ahaz died and Hezekiah became king of Judah. [Isaiah 14:28, 2 Kings 17:6]
- "Do not rejoice, all you of Philistia, Because the rod that struck you is broken; For out of the serpent's roots will come forth a viper, And its offspring will be a fiery flying serpent.
 [Isaiah 14:29]
 - ☆ The northern kingdom of Israel was carried away by the Assyrians in the sixth year of Hezekiah king of Judah which was the ninth year of Hoshea king of Israel. [2 Kings 17:6]
 - ♦ Philistia was subdued under Samuel [1 Samuel 7:13] and again by David [2 Samuel 8:1] they paid tribute to Solomon [2 Kings 4:21] over the years the Philistines regained much territory but were again subjected with defeat at the hand of Uzziah with the help of the Lord and he built cities in the land of Philistia [2 Chronicles 26:6-7] they recovered a little during the time of Ahaz but after the death of Ahaz and during the reign of Hezekiah they were again subdued. [2 Kings 18:5]
