Isaiah 34:1-17 **Against All Nations – Heavens Rolled Up – Edom Desolate**

Indignation of Yahweh against all nations – The Day of Yahweh's Vengeance

- 1 Come near, you nations, to hear; And heed, you people! Let the earth hear, and all that is in it, The world and all things that come forth from it.
- ² For the indignation of the Lord is against all nations, And His fury against all their armies; He has utterly destroyed them, He has given them over to the slaughter.
- ³ Also their slain shall be thrown out; Their stench shall rise from their corpses, And the mountains shall be melted with their blood.

Intent to dissolve the Heavens – Sky rolled up like a scroll

4 All the host of heaven shall be dissolved, And the heavens shall be rolled up like a scroll; All their host shall fall down As the leaf falls from the vine, And as fruit falling from a fig tree.

Judgment against Edom – The Lord's Sacrifice

- ⁵ "For My sword shall be bathed in heaven; Indeed it shall come down on Edom, And on the people of My curse, for judgment.
- ⁶ The sword of the Lord is filled with blood, It is made overflowing with fatness, With the blood of lambs and goats, With the fat of the kidneys of rams. For the Lord has a sacrifice in Bozrah, And a great slaughter in the land of Edom.
- ⁷ The wild oxen shall come down with them, And the young bulls with the mighty bulls; Their land shall be soaked with blood, And their dust saturated with fatness."
- 8 For it is the day of the Lord's vengeance, The year of recompense for the cause of Zion.
- 9 Its streams shall be turned into pitch, And its dust into brimstone; Its land shall become burning pitch.
- 10 It shall not be quenched night or day; Its smoke shall ascend forever. From generation to generation it shall lie waste; No one shall pass through it forever and ever.
- But the pelican and the porcupine shall possess it, Also the owl and the raven shall dwell in it. And He shall stretch out over it The line of confusion and the stones of emptiness.
- 12 They shall call its nobles to the kingdom, But none shall be there, and all its princes shall be nothing.
- 13 And thorns shall come up in its palaces, Nettles and brambles in its fortresses; It shall be a habitation of jackals, A courtyard for ostriches.
- 14 The wild beasts of the desert shall also meet with the jackals, And the wild goat shall bleat to its companion; Also the night creature shall rest there, And find for herself a place of rest.
- 15 There the arrow snake shall make her nest and lay eggs And hatch, and gather them under her shadow; There also shall the hawks be gathered, Every one with her mate.
- ¹⁶ 'Search from the book of the Lord, and read: Not one of these shall fail; Not one shall lack her mate. For My mouth has commanded it, and His Spirit has gathered them.
- 17 He has cast the lot for them, And His hand has divided it among them with a measuring line. They shall possess it forever; From generation to generation they shall dwell in it." NKJV

Facts Revealed:

Indignation of Yahweh against all nations – The Day of Yahweh's Vengeance

☼ Come near, you nations, to hear; And heed, you people! Let the earth hear, and all that is in it, The world and all things that come forth from it.

For the indignation of the Lord is against all nations, And His fury against all their armies; He has utterly destroyed them, He has given them over to the slaughter.

- Also their slain shall be thrown out; Their stench shall rise from their corpses, And the mountains shall be melted with their blood. [Isaiah 34:1-3]
- ♦ The slain by Yahweh will be many at the time of the Great Tribulation is the first warning of this message. [Isaiah 66:15-16, Jeremiah 25:30-33]
- ♦ Yahweh gives these revelations with the intent that the people of the world will take warning and repent of their wicked ways before it is too late when the Day of Wrath is here.

Intent to dissolve the Heavens – Sky rolled up like a scroll

- ☆ All the host of heaven shall be dissolved, And the heavens shall be rolled up like a scroll; All their host shall fall down As the leaf falls from the vine, And as fruit falling from a fig tree.

 [Isaiah 34:4]
 - ♦ Sign of the End Times when the Heavens are impacted by the Wrath of Yahweh. [Matthew 5:18, 24:35, Mark 13:31, Luke 16:17, 21:33, 2 Peter 3:10]
 - ♦ The timing will be at the time of the Great White Throne Judgment, after the final rebellion following the thousand year Rod of Iron Kingdom of strictly enforced righteousness and justice resulting in perfect peaceful environment. [Revelation 20:11]

Judgment against Edom – The Lord's Sacrifice

- □ "For My sword shall be bathed in heaven; Indeed it shall come down on Edom, And on the people of My curse, for judgment.
 - The sword of the Lord is filled with blood, It is made overflowing with fatness, With the blood of lambs and goats, With the fat of the kidneys of rams. For the Lord has a sacrifice in Bozrah, And a great slaughter in the land of Edom. [Isaiah 34:5-6]
 - ♦ Esau was called Edom when he sold his birthright to Jacob for a bowl of red stew. [Genesis 25:29-34]
 - ♦ The land of Edom is the land of Seir where Esau settled when he departed from the land of Canaan which his father Isaac bequeathed to Jacob his brother. [Genesis 36:6-8]
 - ♦ The people of My curse, for judgment, agrees with the message of Malachi. [Malachi 1:1-5]
 - ♦ The reference to Bozrah, and great slaughter in the land of Edom agrees with the mention of the winepress judgment of Isaiah and Revelation. [Isaiah 63:1-6, Revelation 14:18-20, 19:11-16]
 - God views the slaughter as His sacrifice, for the great number of those who will be slain by the Lord. [Isaiah 66:15-16 Jeremiah 25:30-33]
- ☼ The wild oxen shall come down with them, And the young bulls with the mighty bulls; Their land shall be soaked with blood, And their dust saturated with fatness."
 - For it is the day of the **Lord's vengeance**, **The year of recompense for the cause of Zion**. [Isaiah 34:7-8]
 - ♦ The great slaughter of wicked people is viewed by God as a slaughter of sacrificial animals because it is His judgment against all that offends Him.
 - ♦ The amount of blood and fat of those slain at that time would soak the land.
 - ♦ It is the time of the Lord's vengeance and recompense for the sake of Zion His city.
- ❖ Its streams shall be turned into pitch, And its dust into brimstone; Its land shall become burning pitch.

It shall not be quenched night or day; Its smoke shall ascend forever. From generation to generation it shall lie waste; No one shall pass through it forever and ever.

But the pelican and the porcupine shall possess it, Also the owl and the raven shall dwell in it. And He shall stretch out over it The line of confusion and the stones of emptiness. [Isaiah 34:9-11]

- ♦ These verses demonstrate the desolation determined for the land of Edom because or their attitude toward Israel, when Israel was removed from their land and the surrounding nations said, "Aha, the land is our possession." [Ezekiel 25:12-14, 36:1-5, Joel 3:19]
- They shall call its nobles to the kingdom, But none shall be there, and all its princes shall be nothing. [Isaiah 34:12]
 - ♦ Edomites are to be brought to nothing, even their leaders will be no more.
- And thorns shall come up in its palaces, Nettles and brambles in its fortresses; It shall be a habitation of jackals, A courtyard for ostriches.

 The wild beasts of the desert shall also meet with the jackals, And the wild goat shall bleat to its companion; Also the night creature shall rest there, And find for herself a place of rest.

 There the arrow snake shall make her nest and lay eggs And hatch, and gather them under her
 - shadow; There also shall the hawks be gathered, Every one with her mate. [Isaiah 34:13-15] The land of Edom will be void of human habitation and turned over to wild animals.
- ⇒ 'Search from the book of the Lord, and read: Not one of these shall fail; Not one shall lack her mate. For My mouth has commanded it, and His Spirit has gathered them.
 He has cast the lot for them, And His hand has divided it among them with a measuring line.
 They shall possess it forever; From generation to generation they shall dwell in it." [Isaiah 34:16-17]
 - ♦ God challenges us to confirm the message through the Scriptures because it has been faithfully recorded by the writings of the prophets.
