Facts Revealed:

- ➡ "Comfort, yes, comfort My people!" Says Eloheykm (your God). "Speak comfort to Jerusalem, and cry out to her, That her warfare is ended, That her iniquity is pardoned; For she has received from the Lord's hand Double for all her sins." [Isaiah 40:1-2]
 - ♦ Looking forward to the Kingdom age, Isaiah indicates that the time of trouble for Israel is ended, her iniquity is pardoned, and she has paid double for her sins.
 - ❖ That includes all the trouble Israel faced in their fall to the Assyrians, the Babylonians, the time of Greek Hellenism, the time of the Maccabees, and their final scattering after being crushed by the Romans, followed by the persecutions throughout the time of their scattering among the nations, the Holocaust of second world war, their trouble through the Church age, and the Great Tribulation, and the masses lost at the purge of evil from the earth at the start of the Kingdom age.
 - ♦ Israel will certainly have paid double for all her sins then and now.
 - ♦ This includes their tenacious clinging to the traditions of Judaism and rejection of the Savior Yahweh sent to bring understanding of the heart and love of Almighty God by the age of Grace.

- ★ The voice of one crying in the wilderness: Prepare the way of the Lord; Make straight in the desert A highway for our God. [Isaiah 40:3]
 - ♦ This prophesy is fulfilled in the person of John the Baptist. [Matthew 3:3, Luke 3:1-4]
- Every valley shall be exalted And every mountain and hill brought low; The crooked places shall be made straight And the rough places smooth;
 - The glory of the Lord shall be revealed, And all flesh shall see it together; For the mouth of the Lord has spoken." [Isaiah 40:4-5]
 - ♦ The message looks forward to the Kingdom age as described in these verses.
 - ❖ The topography of the earth will be radically changed, and all flesh will indeed see the Glory of the Lord reigning in their presence for a thousand years.
- ❖ The voice said, "Cry out!" And he said, "What shall I cry?"
 - "All flesh is grass, And all its loveliness is like the flower of the field. The grass withers, the flower fades, Because the breath of the Lord blows upon it; Surely the people are grass. The grass withers, the flower fades, But the word of our God stands forever." [Isaiah 40:6-8]
 - → Compared to the Eternal Word of God, the frail life in the human flesh is indeed brief and fades away in a very short time at best.
- ❖ O Zion, You who bring good tidings, Get up into the high mountain; O Jerusalem, You who bring good tidings, Lift up your voice with strength, Lift it up, be not afraid; Say to the cities of Judah, "Behold your God!" [Isaiah 40:9]
 - → The message of the Kingdom age is Emanuel (God with us), as the Lord will be physically present and visible to all on the Throne of David in Zion, where they will be literally able to say, "Behold your God" and everyone will be able to see Him with their own eyes and hear Him with their own ears. [Job 19:25-27, Isaiah 2:2-4, 24:23, Micah 4:1-4, Zechariah 8:3]
- ➡ Behold, the Lord God shall come with a strong hand, And His arm shall rule for Him; Behold, His reward is with Him, And His work before Him. [Isaiah 40:10]
 - ♦ Yeshua is coming to reign with a Rod of Iron over a totally righteous Kingdom of Peace.

 This will be a strictly enforced righteousness with a Judge that knows the truth and cannot be manipulated in judgment. [Psalm 2:9, Revelation 2:27, 12:5, 19:15]
 - ♦ When He comes, He will reward both good and evil for what they have done in the lifetime they were allotted in the flesh to the Day of Judgment. [Romans 14:10-12, 2 Corinthians 5:10]
 - ♦ This applies to the Saints of all time and to the mortals who survive the Great Tribulation. [Matthew 25:31-46]
 - ♦ The work that is before Him is the Judgment Seat of Christ to purge away evil from the earth followed by a thousand years reign as King of kings and Lord of lords in the Righteous Kingdom of God and of Christ. [Malachi 3:1-5, 4:1, Ezekiel 20:33-38, Matthew 13:36-43, 47-50]
- ➡ He will feed His flock like a shepherd; He will gather the lambs with His arm, And carry them in His bosom, And gently lead those who are with young. [Isaiah 40:11]
 - ♦ The Rod of Iron is strictness against any kind of evil, but for the righteous the Lord is tender and protective. [Revelation 7:9-17]
