Yahweh the Awesome God calls the nations to Judgment

- ¹ "Keep silence before Me, O coastlands, And let the people renew their strength! Let them come near, then let them speak; Let us come near together for judgment.
- ² "Who raised up one from the east? Who in righteousness called him to His feet? Who gave the nations before him, And made him rule over kings? Who gave them as the dust to his sword, As driven stubble to his bow? ³ Who pursued them, and passed safely By the way that he had not gone with his feet?
- ⁴ Who has performed and done it, Calling the generations from the beginning? 'I, the Lord, am the first; And with the last I am He.'"

Gentile Idolatry

- 5 The coastlands saw it and feared, The ends of the earth were afraid; They drew near and came.

Encouragement for God's Chosen People

- ♦ Yahweh calls the nations (Gentiles) to keep silent before Him.
- ♦ When Yahweh calls the nations together before Him, it will be an awesome day, no-one will be able to speak before a Holy God.
- ♦ Then He calls them to come together for Judgment.
- ♦ On Judgment Day, God will reveal everything and demonstrate totally righteous justice in judgment because He knows the total truth.
- ♦ Yahweh then identifies Himself as the One who has been in control from the beginning to the End.

- ♦ Yahweh still affirmed that Israel is His chosen people and assured them that He will help
 and uphold them. Israel is not and will not be cast away by God.
- ➡ "Behold, all those who were incensed against you Shall be ashamed and disgraced; They shall be as nothing, And those who strive with you shall perish. You shall seek them and not find them Those who contended with you. Those who war against you Shall be as nothing, As a nonexistent thing.

For I, the Lord your God, will hold your right hand, Saying to you, 'Fear not, I will help you.'

- ♦ God has not cast away His people Israel. [Jeremiah 33:23-26, Romans 11:1-12]
- ♦ At the Battle of Armageddon when all the nations of the world are gathered against Jerusalem and all hope is gone for the people of God, Yahweh assures Israel that the opposing forces are as nothing.
- ♦ The Lord will descend from Heaven with the armies of Heaven following him. [Revelation 19:11-16]
- ♦ From the air like birds flying, Yahweh will defend Jerusalem and Mount Zion. [Isaiah 31:4-5]
- ♦ Yahweh will speak the Word and the enemies will dissolve becoming like nothing.

 [Revelation 19:19-21, Zechariah 14:12-15]
- ♦ The repetitiveness of the assurance indicated its certainty.
