# Isaiah 58:1-14 Religion that pleases Yahweh & Religion which does not

## Unacceptable Religion

- <sup>1</sup> "Cry aloud, spare not; Lift up your voice like a trumpet; Tell My people their transgression, And the house of Jacob their sins.
- <sup>2</sup> Yet they seek Me daily, And delight to know My ways, As a nation that did righteousness, And did not forsake the ordinance of their God. They ask of Me the ordinances of justice; They take delight in approaching God.
- <sup>3</sup> 'Why have we fasted,' they say, 'and You have not seen? Why have we afflicted our souls, and You take no notice?'
- "In fact, in the day of your fast you find pleasure, And exploit all your laborers.
- 4 Indeed you fast for strife and debate, And to strike with the fist of wickedness. You will not fast as you do this day, To make your voice heard on high.

## Acceptable Holiness

- ♦ Unacceptable religion is focused on the individual seeking to please God by some ritualistic function of self centered exaltation. God views it all as transgression.
- ♦ They practice a hypocritical form of religion thinking to be heard on High while they exploit their laborers seeking personal pleasure.
- ♦ They afflict their soul by going without food while they fight and debate with each-other.
- ♦ They bow the head like a bulrush and spread out sackcloth and ashes.
- ♦ God does not respond to such hypocrisy.

### Acceptable Holiness

- → James condensed the concept in his writing: "Pure and undefiled religion before God and
  the Father is this: to visit orphans and widows in their trouble, and to keep oneself
  unspotted from the world." [James 1:27]
- ♦ Self seeking gets you no where with God.
- ♦ Selfless compassion in all areas of life caring for the needy, honoring the Moral Law, like Jesus said, "Love God with all your heart, soul, strength, and mind, and your neighbor as yourself, on these two commandments hang all the Law and the Prophets." [Luke 10:27, Matthew 22:34-40, Mark 12:28-34]
