Timing & Name of God

- 1 Moreover the word of the Lord came to Jeremiah a second time, while he was still shut up in the court of the prison, saying,
- 2 "Thus says the Lord who made it, the Lord who formed it to establish it (the Lord is His name):
- ³ 'Call to Me, and I will answer you, and show you great and mighty things, which you do not know.'

Sin caused pending destruction

- 4 "For thus says the Lord, the God of Israel, concerning the houses of this city and the houses of the kings of Judah, which have been pulled down to fortify against the siege mounds and the sword:
- ⁵ 'They come to fight with the Chaldeans, but only to fill their places with the dead bodies of men whom I will slay in My anger and My fury, all for whose wickedness I have hidden My face from this city.

Future Restoration, Peace, Forgiveness & Cleansing

- ⁶ Behold, I will bring it health and healing; I will heal them and reveal to them the abundance of peace and truth.
- ⁷ And I will cause the captives of Judah and the captives of Israel to return, and will rebuild those places as at the first.
- 8 I will cleanse them from all their iniquity by which they have sinned against Me, and I will pardon all their iniquities by which they have sinned and by which they have transgressed against Me.

Resulting World Fame and Glory to Yahweh

- 9 Then it shall be to Me a name of joy, a praise, and an honor before all nations of the earth, who shall hear all the good that I do to them; they shall fear and tremble for all the goodness and all the prosperity that I provide for it.'
- 10 "Thus says the Lord: 'Again there shall be heard in this place of which you say, "It is desolate, without man and without beast" in the cities of Judah, in the streets of Jerusalem that are desolate, without man and without inhabitant and without beast,
- the voice of joy and the voice of gladness, the voice of the bridegroom and the voice of the bride, the voice of those who will say: "Praise the Lord of hosts, For the Lord is good, For His mercy endures forever" and of those who will bring the sacrifice of praise into the house of the Lord. For I will cause the captives of the land to return as at the first,' says the Lord.
- 12 "Thus says the Lord of hosts: 'In this place which is desolate, without man and without beast, and in all its cities, there shall again be a dwelling place of shepherds causing their flocks to lie down. 13 In the cities of the mountains, in the cities of the lowland, in the cities of the South, in the land of Benjamin, in the places around Jerusalem, and in the cities of Judah, the flocks shall again pass under the hands of him who counts them,' says the Lord.

Kingdom Fame – Branch of Righteousness

¹⁴ 'Behold, the days are coming,' says the Lord, 'that I will perform that good thing which I have promised to the house of Israel and to the house of Judah:

- 22 As the host of heaven cannot be numbered, nor the sand of the sea measured, so will I multiply the descendants of David My servant and the Levites who minister to Me."

World hatred of the Jews

- 23 Moreover the word of the Lord came to Jeremiah, saying,
- ²⁴ "Have you not considered what these people have spoken, saying, 'The two families which the Lord has chosen, He has also cast them off? Thus they have despised My people, as if they should no more be a nation before them.

Yahweh's Assurance of His enduring care for Israel and David

- 25 "Thus says the Lord: 'If My covenant is not with day and night, and if I have not appointed the ordinances of heaven and earth,
- ²⁶ then I will cast away the descendants of Jacob and David My servant, so that I will not take any of his descendants to be rulers over the descendants of Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob.

For I will cause their captives to return, and will have mercy on them."

- ☼ Moreover the word of Yahweh (the Lord) came to Jeremiah a second time, while he was still shut up in the court of the prison, saying,
 - "Thus says Yahweh (the Lord) who made it, Yahweh (the Lord) who formed it to establish it (Yahweh (is His name):
 - 'Call to Me, and I will answer you, and show you great and mighty things, which you do not know.' [Jeremiah 33:1-3]
 - → Jeremiah was shut up in the court of the prison on the tenth year of Zedekiah and remained in prison until Jerusalem fell the eleventh year of Zedekiah.
 - ♦ Yahweh spoke to Jeremiah the second time while he was in prison.
 - ♦ Yahweh introduced Himself as the Creator of all and identified Himself by the name of Yahweh, just as He had first given His name Yahweh to Moses. [Exodus 6:2-3, Jeremiah 33:2]
 - ♦ Yahweh invited Jeremiah to call on Him and He will reveal great and mighty things.

Sin caused pending destruction

☼ "For thus says Yahweh Elohey Yisrael (the Lord, the God of Israel), concerning the houses of this city and the houses of the kings of Judah, which have been pulled down to fortify against the siege mounds and the sword:

'They come to fight with the Chaldeans, but only to fill their places with the dead bodies of men whom I will slay in My anger and My fury, all for whose wickedness I have hidden My face from this city. [Jeremiah 33:4-5]

- ♦ The great houses of the city have already been torn down to fortify against the Chaldeans who have the city under siege.
- ♦ Yahweh informed the king that his defense against the Chaldeans will fail because Yahweh Himself will deliver them into the hands of their enemy because of their sins and wickedness.
- ♦ Yahweh Himself will slay many, just as He will at the time of the end called "the Winepress of the Wrath of God" of the Great Tribulation [Revelation 14:18-20, 19:11-16] Future Restoration, Peace, Forgiveness & Cleansing
 - **⇔** Behold, I will bring it health and healing; I will heal them and reveal to them the abundance of peace and truth.

And I will cause the captives of Judah and the captives of Israel to return, and will rebuild those places as at the first.

I will cleanse them from all their iniquity by which they have sinned against Me, and I will pardon all their iniquities by which they have sinned and by which they have transgressed against Me. [Jeremiah 33:6-8]

- ♦ In the midst of punishing Judah for their sins, Yahweh gives a light at the end by referring to the restoration of Israel and Judah in the Kingdom age.
- ♦ The Kingdom will bring abundance of peace and truth, health and healing,
- ♦ The captives of Judah will return and rebuild Judah and Jerusalem.
- ♦ Yahweh will pardon all sins and iniquities of the people, cleansing them for the Kingdom.

 - Then it shall be to Me a name of joy, a praise, and an honor before all nations of the earth, who shall hear all the good that I do to them; they shall fear and tremble for all the goodness and all the prosperity that I provide for it.'

"Thus says Yahweh (the Lord): 'Again there shall be heard in this place — of which you say, "It is desolate, without man and without beast" — in the cities of Judah, in the streets of Jerusalem that are desolate, without man and without inhabitant and without beast, the voice of joy and the voice of gladness, the voice of the bridegroom and the voice of the bride, the voice of those who will say: "Praise Yahweh Tsebaovt (the Lord of hosts), For Yahweh (the Lord) is good, For His mercy endures forever" — and of those who will bring the sacrifice of praise into Beit Yahweh (the House of the Lord). For I will cause the captives of the land to return as at the first,' says the Lord.

♦ Yahweh will use Israel as a source of fame, praise, and honor for Himself before all nations of the earth as they see clearly that Yahweh of Israel is a God of His Word, punishing Israel when they sin, and blessing them abundantly as they are obedient to His Word.

Kingdom Fame – Branch of Righteousness

'In those days and at that time I will cause to grow up to David A Branch of righteousness; He shall execute judgment and righteousness in the earth.

In those days Judah will be saved, And Jerusalem will dwell safely. And this is the name by which she will be called: YAHWEH TSIDQUNEW (THE LORD OUR RIGHTEOUSNESS).' [Jeremiah 33:14-16]

- ♦ Yahweh's focus is continually on the Kingdom when righteousness will be common and He will respond with all the good things He has promised to Israel throughout history.
- ♦ It is the time when Messiah Yeshua will be King of kings and Lord of lords reigning personally from Zion in Jerusalem. [1 Timothy 6:13-16, Revelation 17:14, 19:11-16]
- ♦ Perfect righteousness will result in perfect peace and security.
- ♦ Jerusalem will be called by the name of the King, YAHWEH TSIDQUNEW.

As the host of heaven cannot be numbered, nor the sand of the sea measured, so will I multiply the descendants of David My servant and the Levites who minister to Me." [Jeremiah 33:17-22]

♦ Yahweh's covenant with David and the priests and Levites is eternal as is the forces of Nature He has created.

World hatred of the Jews

- ☼ Moreover the word of Yahweh (the Lord) came to Jeremiah, saying, "Have you not considered what these people have spoken, saying, 'The two families which Yahweh (the Lord) has chosen, He has also cast them off'? Thus they have despised My people, as if they should no more be a nation before them. [Jeremiah 33:23-24]
 - ♦ Yahweh indicated the anti-Semitic attitude the Gentiles would hold of the Jews when they have been scattered from the Promised Land.
 - ♦ This attitude was prevalent in the Babylonian captivity and again after the Jews were scattered by the Romans.
 - ♦ It is behind the attitude that caused many Christians to originate the theory that the Church replaced Israel, calling the Jews "Christ killers" and claiming God has cast Israel away in favor of the Church.

Yahweh's Assurance of His enduring care for Israel and David

- □ "Thus says Yahweh (the Lord): 'If My covenant is not with day and night, and if I have not appointed the ordinances of heaven and earth,
 - then I will cast away the descendants of Jacob and David My servant, so that I will not take any of his descendants to be rulers over the descendants of Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob.

For I will cause their captives to return, and will have mercy on them." [Jeremiah 33:25-26]

- ♦ Yahweh declared that the replacement theory is incorrect by affirming His permanent care for Israel and for David.
- ♦ Yahweh's covenant with Israel and David is as certain as the continuation of day and night.
- ❖ Yahweh will show mercy and bring the Children of Israel and David back to the Land of Israel for the Kingdom age as confirmed in many messages of prophesy, both Old Testament and New Testament.
