John 14:12-14 Believers will do Greater works than Jesus

12 "Most assuredly, I say to you, he who believes in Me, the works that I do he will do also; and greater works than these he will do, because I go to My Father.

If you ask anything in My Name I will do it

13 And whatever you ask in My name, that I will do, that the Father may be glorified in the Son. 14 If you ask anything in My name, I will do it. NKJV

Facts Revealed:

- The "Most assuredly, I say to you, he who believes in Me, the works that I do he will do also; and greater works than these he will do, because I go to My Father. [John 14:12]
 - → The Greek word (meizon) is being interpreted to say "greater" works than these he will do, and the word (meizon) stands for greater in number, more, not greater in quality.
 - ♦ Jesus gives the reason He used this term by saying, "Because I go to My Father."
 - ♦ Jesus' works of miracles ended on the third year of His ministry by His death, resurrection, and ascension, while the disciples were left here to continue the same works to the end of their lives. [Mark 16:17-18, 20, Acts 2:42-47, 3:1-26, 4:32-37, 5:12-16, 6:8-15, 8:5-17, 9:1-19, 13:6-12, 14:1-6, 8-20, 16:16-40, 19:11-12, 20:6-12, 28:1-10, Romans 15:17-21, 2 Corinthians 12:12, Hebrews 2:1-4]
- And whatever you ask in My name, that I will do, that the Father may be glorified in the Son. If you ask anything in My name, I will do it. [John 14:13-14]
 - ♦ Whatever we ask, we will receive, if we ask according to His Will. [1 John 5:14-15]
 - ♦ Whatever we as obedient children ask, believing, we will receive, however to believe, we need to know the will of the Father and of Jesus, and be praying in accordance with it.

 [Matthew 21:22, Mark 11:24, 1 John 3:16-22]
 - ♦ We will not receive anything we pray for if we ask amiss for something against the Will of the Father or of Jesus. [James 4:3]
 - ❖ The Father is glorified in the Son, when we as obedient children, ask and receive what we asked for, because we asked according to His Will.
 - ♦ When we ask **in the Name of Jesus**, we are asking by the authority Jesus granted us, by which we may come before the Father with our request.
 - ♦ We need to keep our requests in line with that such as we would expect Jesus to ask if it were Him doing the asking.
 - ♦ Then our holy request has the assurance that God will grant it to the glory of His Son, and it will in return bring glory to the Father.
 - ♦ Ask in Holiness and in the Will of God, you will receive the right response from the Father.
