

## John 1:9-13 **The True Light**

9 That was the true Light which gives light to every man coming into the world. 10 He was in the world, and the world was made through Him, and the world did not know Him. 11 He came to His own, and His own did not receive Him. 12 But as many as received Him, to them He gave the right to become children of God, to those who believe in His name: 13 who were born, not of blood, nor of the will of the flesh, nor of the will of man, but of God. NKJV

### Facts Revealed:

- ✚ Jesus is the One Who has revealed the Godhead to mankind from the very first and is the one Who gives light (understanding) to every man coming into the world. [John 1:9, 18, 3:16-21, 8:12, 9:3-5, 12:35-36, 44-46, Matthew 4:15-16, Luke 2:28-32, Acts 26:12-18, 22-23, 2 Corinthians 4:1-6, Ephesians 5:8-14, 2 Timothy 1:8-11, 6:13-16, 1 Peter 2:9-10, 2 Peter 1:16-21, 1 John 1:5-7, 2:8-11, Revelation 21:23-24, 22:5]
- ✧ The True Light is Jesus, God the Word, through Whom all creation was created. [John 1:1-5]
- ✧ All things were made through God the Word, and nothing was made without Him. [John 1:1-3, Ephesians 3:8-9, Colossians 1:9-17, Hebrews 1:1-4, 11:3]
  - ✧ Therefore Jesus, God the Word, was not a created being, Jesus was the express Word of God Who resided with God before Creation, and through Whom all things were created.
  - ✧ Therefore, Jesus was present with God at the first of all creation and has preeminence over all creation, since it was through Him all things were made. [Colossians 1:15-18]
- ✧ Life resided in God the Word. [John 1:4, 5:26]
- ✧ The Life residing in God the Word was the light of men. [John 1:4, 8:12, 12:46, Micah 7:8, 2 Corinthians 4:6, Ephesians 5:8, 1 Peter 2:9]
- ✧ The Light shines in the darkness, and the darkness did not understand it. [John 1:5, Isaiah 9:2, Matthew 4:16]
- ✚ Jesus the Creating Word of God was in the world, and the world did not know Him. [John 1:10, Luke 19:44, Acts 13:26-29, 1 Corinthians 2:8-9, 1 John 3:1-2]
  - ✧ He came to His own (the Jewish People) and His own did not receive Him. [John 1:11]
  - ✧ But as many as received Him, to them He gave the right to become children of God, to those who believe in His name, who were born, not of blood, nor of the will of the flesh, nor of the will of man, but of God.: [John 1:12-13, 3:3-8, 14-18, 36, 5:24, 5:42-47, 6:29, 40, 47, 8:30, 10:42, 11:45, 12:10-11, 42-47, 20:29-31, Mark 16:16-17, Luke 8:12, Acts 21:20, Romans 3:19-23, Galatians 3:22]
