Josh 13:1-7 Lands Yet To Be Conquered – Command of Yehowah

Joshua is old and Yehowah gave him a command to conquer the remainder of the land. 1 Now Joshua was old, advanced in years. And the LORD said to him: "You are old, advanced in years, and there remains very much land yet to be possessed.

Specific lands yet to be conquered – With the promise of God to help accomplish it

² This is the land that yet remains: all the territory of the **Philistines** and all that of the **Geshurites**, ³ from Sihor, which is east of Egypt, as far as the border of Ekron northward (which is counted as Canaanite); the five lords of the Philistines--the **Gazites**, the **Ashdodites**, the **Ashkelonites**, the **Gittites**, and the **Ekronites**; also the **Avites**; 4 from the south, all the land of the **Canaanites**, and **Mearah** that belongs to the Sidonians as far as Aphek, to the border of the Amorites; 5 the land of the **Gebalites**, and all **Lebanon**, toward the sunrise, from Baal Gad below Mount Hermon as far as the entrance to Hamath; 6 all the inhabitants of the mountains from Lebanon as far as the Brook Misrephoth, and all the Sidonians--them I will drive out from before the children of Israel; only divide it by lot to Israel as an inheritance, as I have commanded you. 7 Now therefore, divide this land as an inheritance to the nine tribes and half the tribe of Manasseh." NKJV

 - ♦ When Joshua was old, God gave him instructions concerning the land remaining for Israel to take possession.

- 2 This is the land that yet remains:
 - From the South [Joshua 13:2-3]
 - \diamond All the territory of the **Philistines**
 - \diamond All that of the **Geshurites**
 - ♦ From Sihor, which is east of Egypt, as far as the border of Ekron northward (which is counted as Canaanite);
 - ¤ Sihor also called Shihor is a river on the Eastern border of Egypt, probably the one called the "River of Egypt" and the "Brook of Egypt" mentioned as the southern boundary of the Promised Land. [Genesis 15:18, Numbers 34:5, Joshua 15:4, 2 Kings 24:7] Some have guessed it to be Wady-el 'Arish.
 - Ekron is the northern most of the five major cities of the Philistines, Gaza, Ashdod, Ashkelon, Gath of the Gittites, and Ekron.
 - □ The Avites were nomadic people scattered throughout the Shephelah (lower hills of Judea) as far as Gaza.

To the North [Joshua 13:4-7]

- All the land of the Canaanites, and Mearah that belongs to the Sidonians as far as Aphek, to the border of the Amorites. [Joshua 13:4]
 - □ The Canaanites were the first inhabitants of the land of Canaan (Promised Land) who
 was a son of Ham the son of Noah. [Genesis 10:6]
 - ☐ Canaan received the curse from Noah when Ham violated his drunken father. [Genesis 9:20-26]
 - ^{μ} The land of Canaan extended from Sidon to Gaza. [Genesis 10:19]
 - ^{\square} Mearah belonging to the Sidonians is an area of caves east of Sidon.

- ⊭ Aphek is listed with "to the border of the Amorites," which would suggest Aphek is eastward toward Syria and east of the Sea of Galilee.
- ☆ The land of the Gebalites, and all Lebanon, toward the sunrise, from Baal Gad below Mount Hermon as far as the entrance to Hamath, all the inhabitants of the mountains from Lebanon as far as the Brook Misrephoth, and all the Sidonians [Joshua 13:5-6]
 - □ The Gebalites were from a north Lebanon Phoenician city about 5 miles north of Beirut, and experts as masons and stone cutters. [1 Kings 5:18, Ezekiel 27:9]
 - □ The term "All the land of Lebanon indicates that God originally intended for Israel to possess land far beyond the borders they eventually possessed. During the Kingdom age when Messiah Jesus reigns a thousand years the borders will be the full land promised to Israel.
 - □ From Baal Gad below Mount Hermon as far as Hamath indicates that from Mount Hermon northward was land originally included.
 - ➡ Hamath is a Syrian city about 125 miles north of Damascus about the same longitude as the island of Cyprus. That would certainly include all of Lebanon and a great part of Syria as the text indicates.
 - It would certainly include all the inhabitants of the mountains of Lebanon and all the Sidonians.
 - [⊥] The **Brook Misrephoth** is believed to be waters from hot springs called burning waters near Sidon.
- Them I will drive out from before the children of Israel; only divide it by lot to Israel as an inheritance, as I have commanded you. Now therefore, divide this land as an inheritance to the nine tribes and half the tribe of Manasseh." [Joshua 13:6-7]
 - \diamond God promised to deliver it all into the hands of Israel.
 - \diamond The command is to divide the land to the 9 ½ tribes of Israel.
 - The closest Israel came to possessing all the promised land was during the reign of Solomon. [1 Kings 4:24-25]
 - The complete possession of the Promised Land will be during the Kingdom reign of Messiah. [Ezekiel 47:13-20]
