#### Seven remaining Tribes

<sup>2</sup> But there remained among the children of Israel seven tribes which had not yet received their inheritance.

#### Advice to survey the remaining land into seven parcels for the seven remaining tribes

<sup>3</sup> Then Joshua said to the children of Israel: "How long will you neglect to go and possess the land which the LORD God of your fathers has given you? <sup>4</sup> Pick out from among you three men for each tribe, and I will send them; they shall rise and go through the land, survey it according to their inheritance, and come back to me. <sup>5</sup> And they shall divide it into seven parts. Judah shall remain in their territory on the south, and the house of Joseph shall remain in their territory on the north. <sup>6</sup> You shall therefore survey the land in seven parts and bring the survey here to me, that I may cast lots for you here before the LORD our God.

#### Surveyors report back to Shiloh

## Advice to survey the remaining land into seven parcels for the seven remaining tribes

 $\Rightarrow$  Then Joshua said to the children of Israel:

"How long will you neglect to go and possess the land which the LORD God of your fathers has given you? 4 Pick out from among you three men for each tribe, and I will send them; they shall rise and go through the land, survey it according to their inheritance, and come back to me. <sup>5</sup> And they shall divide it into seven parts. Judah shall remain in their territory on the south, and the house of Joseph shall remain in their territory on the north. <sup>6</sup> You shall therefore survey the land in seven parts and bring the survey here to me, that I may cast lots for you here before the LORD our God." [Joshua 18:3-6]

- ♦ The purpose of the survey is to establish boundaries for seven parcels of the land remaining.
- ☆ The apportionment of the land will be by lot according to the command of Yehowah. [Joshua 18:6, Numbers 26:52-56, 33:50-54, Joshua 13:1-7, 14:1-2]
