## Judges 10:1-5 Two Judges followed Gideon - Tola & Jair

After Abimelech's 3 years as king, God sent two judges in sequential order for 45 years <sup>1</sup> After Abimelech there arose to save Israel Tola the son of Puah, the son of Dodo, a man of Issachar; and he dwelt in Shamir in the mountains of Ephraim. <sup>2</sup> He judged Israel twenty-three years; and he died and was buried in Shamir.

<sup>3</sup> After him arose Jair, a Gileadite; and he judged Israel twenty-two years. <sup>4</sup> Now he had thirty sons who rode on thirty donkeys; they also had thirty towns, which are called "Havoth Jair" to this day, which are in the land of Gilead. <sup>5</sup> And Jair died and was buried in Camon. NKJV
