Leviticus 22:26-33 Special Sacrifice Laws

26 And the LORD spoke to Moses, saying:

Age of Sacrifice

²⁷ "When a bull or a sheep or a goat is born, it shall be seven days with its mother; and from the eighth day and thereafter it shall be accepted as an offering made by fire to the LORD.

Mother and Young

28 Whether it is a cow or ewe, do not kill both her and her young on the same day.

Thanksgiving

29 And when you offer a sacrifice of thanksgiving to the LORD, offer it of your own free will. 30 On the same day it shall be eaten; you shall leave none of it until morning: I am the LORD.

Do not profane the Name of Yehowah

31 "Therefore you shall keep My commandments, and perform them: I am the LORD. 32 You shall not profane My holy name, but I will be hallowed among the children of Israel. I am the LORD who sanctifies you, 33 who brought you out of the land of Egypt, to be your God: I am the LORD." NKJV

Facts Revealed:

- An animal must be at least 8 days old to be acceptable as an Offering made by fire. [Leviticus 22:27]
- A mother and her young may not be killed on the same day. [Leviticus 22:28, Deuteronomy 22:6, Exodus 23:19, 34:26, Deuteronomy 14:21, 22:6-7]
- Sacrifice of Thanksgiving must be eaten the day it is offered, none may remain until morning.
 [Leviticus 22:29-30, 7:15]
- **You must keep and perform the commandments of Yehowah.** [Leviticus 22:31, Genesis 17:9, 18:19, Exodus 15:26, 19:5, 20:6, Leviticus 18:4-5, 26, 30, 20:8, 22:9]
- ♦ You may not profane the Name of Yehowah. [Leviticus 22:32, 18:21, 19:12, 20:3, 21:6, 22:2]
- ❖ Yehowah must be hallowed among the Children of Israel. [Leviticus 22:32, 10:3]
- ♦ Yehowah is the One Who sanctifies you. [Leviticus 22:32, Exodus 13:13, Leviticus 20:8, 21:15, 21:23]
- \Psi Yehowah is the One Who brought the Children of Israel out of the Land of Egypt. [Leviticus 22:33, Exodus 3:7-12, 13:3-9, 14, 20:2, 29:46, Leviticus 11:45, 19:36]
- Yehowah's purpose for bringing Israel out of the land of Egypt was to be their God. [Leviticus 22:33, Genesis 17:7-8, Exodus 6:7, 16:12, 29:45, Leviticus 11:45, 26:45]
