Leviticus 24:1-9 Oil for the Lampstand – and the Showbread

1 Then the LORD spoke to Moses, saying:

Oil for the Lamp

- 2 "Command the children of Israel that they bring to you pure oil of pressed olives for the light, to make the lamps burn continually. 3 Outside the veil of the Testimony, in the tabernacle of meeting, Aaron shall be in charge of it from evening until morning before the LORD continually; it shall be a statute forever in your generations.
- 4 He shall be in charge of the lamps on the pure gold lampstand before the LORD continually.

Showbread

- 5 "And you shall take fine flour and bake twelve cakes with it. Two-tenths of an ephah shall be in each cake.
- 6 You shall set them in two rows, six in a row, on the pure gold table before the LORD.
- ⁷ And you shall put pure frankincense on each row, that it may be on the bread for a memorial, an offering made by fire to the LORD.
- 8 Every Sabbath he shall set it in order before the LORD continually, being taken from the children of Israel by an everlasting covenant.
- 9 And it shall be for Aaron and his sons, and they shall eat it in a holy place; for it is most holy to him from the offerings of the LORD made by fire, by a perpetual statute." NKJV

Facts Revealed:

Oil for the Lamp

- \Phi Pure Olive Oil is provided by the Children of Israel. [Exodus 25:1-6, 27:20-21, Leviticus 24:1-4]
- ❖ Aaron is responsible for tending the oil and light on the Gold Lampstand. [Exodus 27:20-21]
- ♦ It is a perpetual statute forever in your generations. [Exodus 27:20-21, 30:7, Leviticus 24:1-4]
- **☼** This is the Ner Tormid (perpetual light) to be burning continually. [Exodus 27:20-21]

Showbread

- ❖ Showbread is taken from the Children of Israel by a everlasting covenant.
- ❖ Showbread is to be on the Table of Showbread continually. [Exodus 25:30]
 - ♦ Showbread is to be 12 cakes made of two tenths of an ephah of fine flour each.
- **☼** The 12 cakes are set in two rows of 6 cakes each.
- The Frankincense on the bread is to be used as a memorial Burnt Offering made by fire to Yehowah. [Leviticus 2:2, 16, 24:7]
- **☼** The Bread is changed each Sabbath.
- **☼** The bread is to be eaten by Aaron and his sons in a holy place.
- **☼** It is most holy to him from the offerings of Yehowah made by fire.
- **☼** This is a perpetual statute.
