## Leviticus 3:1-17 Peace Offerings

## Ox

<sup>1</sup> 'When his offering is a sacrifice of a peace offering, if he offers it of the herd, whether male or female, he shall offer it without blemish before the LORD. <sup>2</sup> And he shall lay his hand on the head of his offering, and kill it at the door of the tabernacle of meeting; and Aaron's sons, the priests, shall sprinkle the blood all around on the altar. <sup>3</sup> Then he shall offer from the sacrifice of the peace offering an offering made by fire to the LORD. The fat that covers the entrails and all the fat that is on the entrails, <sup>4</sup> the two kidneys and the fat that is on them by the flanks, and the fatty lobe attached to the liver above the kidneys, he shall remove; <sup>5</sup> and Aaron's sons shall burn it on the altar upon the burnt sacrifice, which is on the wood that is on the fire, as an offering made by fire, a sweet aroma to the LORD.

## Sheep

<sup>6</sup> 'If his offering as a sacrifice of a peace offering to the LORD is of the flock, whether male or female, he shall offer it without blemish. <sup>7</sup> If he offers a lamb as his offering, then he shall offer it before the LORD. <sup>8</sup> And he shall lay his hand on the head of his offering, and kill it before the tabernacle of meeting; and Aaron's sons shall sprinkle its blood all around on the altar. <sup>9</sup> Then he shall offer from the sacrifice of the peace offering, as an offering made by fire to the LORD, its fat and the whole fat tail which he shall remove close to the backbone. And the fat that covers the entrails and all the fat that is on the entrails, <sup>10</sup> the two kidneys and the fat that is on them by the flanks, and the fatty lobe attached to the liver above the kidneys, he shall remove; <sup>11</sup> and the priest shall burn them on the altar as food, an offering made by fire to the LORD.

## Goat

<sup>12</sup> 'And if his offering is a goat, then he shall offer it before the LORD. <sup>13</sup> He shall lay his hand on its head and kill it before the tabernacle of meeting; and the sons of Aaron shall sprinkle its blood all around on the altar. <sup>14</sup> Then he shall offer from it his offering, as an offering made by fire to the LORD. The fat that covers the entrails and all the fat that is on the entrails, <sup>15</sup> the two kidneys and the fat that is on them by the flanks, and the fatty lobe attached to the liver above the kidneys, he shall remove; <sup>16</sup> and the priest shall burn them on the altar as food, an offering made by fire for a sweet aroma; all the fat is the LORD's.

17 'This shall be a perpetual statute throughout your generations in all your dwellings: you shall eat neither fat nor blood.' " NKJV

Facts Revealed:

- ☆ Peace Offerings relates the union of "Fellowship with Almighty God"
- ☆ After the one bringing the offering, lays his hands on its head transferring his sins onto the sacrifice, then kills the offering at the door of the Tabernacle of Meeting showing that our sins brought Messiah Jesus to the cross.
- ☆ The Priest then sprinkles the blood around the Altar showing that it is the BLOOD that provides covering for sin.
- ✤ It also speaks of the blood of Messiah Jesus which was sprinkled all around the foot of the cross for the trespasses of all the world when He died bearing all our sins.
- The portions of the Peace Offering for burning are removed and placed upon the altar, on the burnt sacrifice, which is on the wood that is on the fire a sweet smelling aroma to Yehowah.

☆ No fat is to be eaten nor blood. <u>Fat</u> represents "increase or prosperity" which belongs to the Lord along with the <u>blood</u>, which is "life" – reserved by God for the covering of sin. [Hebrews 9:22, 1 Peter 1:19, Leviticus 17:11] also [Genesis 9:3-4, Leviticus 3:17, 7:26-27, 17:10-14, 19:26, Deuteronomy 12:16, 23-25, 26-27, 15:23, Acts 15:20, 29, 21:25, Hebrews 9:22]

[Leviticus 3:1-17, 7:11-21] MESSIAH JESUS is our PEACE OFFERING, "For HE **HIMSELF is our peace, who has made both one, and has broken down the middle wall of separation.**" [Ephesians 2:14]
