Leviticus 6:24-30 Law of the Sin Offering

²⁴ And the LORD spoke to Moses, saying, ²⁵ "Speak to Aaron and to his sons, saying, "This is the law of the sin offering: In the place where the burnt offering is killed, the sin offering shall be killed before the LORD. It is most holy. ²⁶ The priest who offers it for sin shall eat it. In a holy place it shall be eaten, in the court of the tabernacle of meeting. ²⁷ Everyone who touches its flesh must be holy. And when its blood is sprinkled on any garment, you shall wash that on which it was sprinkled, in a holy place. ²⁸ But the earthen vessel in which it is boiled shall be broken. And if it is boiled in a bronze pot, it shall be both scoured and rinsed in water. ²⁹ All the males among the priests may eat it. It is most holy.

³⁰ But no sin offering from which any of the blood is brought into the tabernacle of meeting, to make atonement in the holy place, shall be eaten. It shall be burned in the fire. NKJV

Facts Revealed:

- The "Law of the Sin Offering" refers to the responsibility of the priest concerning it.
- The Sin Offering is killed in the same place the Burnt Offering is killed.
- \Rightarrow The Priest who offers it shall eat it in a holy place in the court of the Tabernacle.
- \Rightarrow Everyone who touches its flesh must be holy.
- \Rightarrow Garments sprinkled with its blood shall be washed in a holy place.
- ☆ The earthen vessel in which it is boiled shall be broken. If it is boiled in a bronze pot, the pot shall be scoured and rinsed in water.
- \Rightarrow All the males among the priests may eat it.
- \Rightarrow It is most holy.
- ☆ No Sin Offering from which any of the blood is brought into the Tabernacle of Meeting, to make Atonement in the Holy Place shall be eaten. It shall be burned with fire.
- ☆ Atonement speaks of the work of Messiah Jesus as He becomes the final sacrifice to satisfy Almighty God's requirement for our reconciliation which is provided by His blood through faith that He might be the justifier of the one who has faith in Jesus. [Romans 3:21-26, Hebrews 2:14-18, 1 John 2:1-2, 4:7-11]
