Leviticus 6:8-13 LAW OF THE BURNT OFFERING

⁸ Then the LORD spoke to Moses, saying, ⁹ "Command Aaron and his sons, saying, "This is the law of the burnt offering: The burnt offering shall be on the hearth upon the altar all night until morning, and the fire of the altar shall be kept burning on it. ¹⁰ And the priest shall put on his linen garment, and his linen trousers he shall put on his body, and take up the ashes of the burnt offering which the fire has consumed on the altar, and he shall put them beside the altar. ¹¹ Then he shall take off his garments, put on other garments, and carry the ashes outside the camp to a clean place. ¹² And the fire on the altar shall be kept burning on it; it shall not be put out. And the priest shall burn wood on it every morning, and lay the burnt offering in order on it; and he shall burn on it the fat of the peace offerings. ¹³ A fire shall always be burning on the altar; it shall never go out. NKJV

Facts Revealed:

- ☆ The "Law of the Burnt Offering" refers to the responsibility of the Priest concerning it.
- ☆ The fire on the copper (or bronze) Altar shall never go out, it is to be kept burning continually.
- ☆ The Burnt Offering shall be on the hearth upon the Altar all night until morning.
- ☆ The Priest, wearing his linen garment and linen trousers, shall take the ashes of the Burnt Offering and place them beside the Altar. Then he takes off the linen garments of his priesthood, and puts on other common clothing in which he will take the ashes from beside the Altar to a clean place outside the camp.
- The priest shall keep the fire burning on the altar, and in the morning he shall put wood on the fire and lay the Burnt Offering in order on it. He shall also burn on it the fat of the Peace Offerings
- The significance of the Burnt Offering is covered in the notes on [Leviticus 1:1-17].
