Blessing for the Faithful

Punishment for the Unfaithful

Punishment according to what was entrusted to the individual.

⁴⁷ And that servant who knew his master's will, and did not prepare himself or do according to his will, shall be beaten with many stripes. ⁴⁸ But he who did not know, yet committed things deserving of stripes, shall be beaten with few. For everyone to whom much is given, from him much will be required; and to whom much has been committed, of him they will ask the more. NKJV

Facts Revealed:

Command to Watch for the Return of The Lord

- Let your waist be girded and your lamps burning; and you yourselves be like men who wait for their master, when he will return from the wedding, that when he comes and knocks they may open to him immediately. [Luke 12:35-36]
 - \diamond The command focuses on the wedding from which the Master is returning.
 - \diamond The timing is just before the rewards are given, both good and bad.

- \diamond This speaks of the marriage of the Lamb. [Revelation 19:7-9]
- ☆ The rewards are given after the marriage and after the Master returns and at the start of the thousand year Kingdom Reign of Christ. [Revelation 20:4-6]

Blessing for the Faithful

- Blessed are those servants whom the master, when he comes, will find watching. Assuredly, I say to you that he will gird himself and have them sit down to eat, and will come and serve them. And if he should come in the second watch, or come in the third watch, and find them so, blessed are those servants. [Luke 12:37-38]
 - ♦ When Jesus comes to set up His Kingdom, He will reward the Saints. [Revelation 11:16-18, Matthew 16:27, Revelation 22:12, Mark 8:38, Luke 9:26]
 - ♦ The Rewards will be marvelous. Blessing for the Faithful

- Blessed is that servant whom his master will find so doing when he comes. Truly, I say to you that he will make him ruler over all that he has. [Luke 12:43-44, Matthew 24:46-47]
- Jesus has just spoken of the catching away of the Saints and the urgency to watch and be ready because the day and hour is unknown to man, angels, or Jesus, and only the Father knows the time appointed for that event. [Matthew 24:36-44, Mark 13:32-37, Luke 17:34-36, 1 Thessalonians 4:16-17]
- ✤ Now Jesus gives an illustration of His meaning in the teaching and command to watch.
 - ☆ The Master has left His servants with the responsible of caring for his Household while He is gone to a far country. [Matthew 24:45-51, Mark 13:34-37, Luke 12:35-38, 42-46]
 - $\, \varkappa \,$ The servants represent believers in the Church.
 - ☐ The Master represents Jesus.
 - \diamond The Master will certainly come at the appointed time.
 - \diamond When He arrives, it will be time for accounting.
 - ☆ The servant found faithfully fulfilling his appointed task, will be rewarded abundantly. [Matthew 24:46-47, Luke 12:43-44]

Punishment for the Unfaithful

- But if that servant says in his heart, 'My master is delaying his coming,' and begins to beat the male and female servants, and to eat and drink and be drunk, [Luke 12:45, Matthew 24:48-49]
 The master of that servant will come on a day when he is not looking for him, and at an hour when he is not aware, and will cut him in two and appoint him his portion with the unbelievers. [Luke 12:46, Matthew 24:50-51]
 - ☆ The servant who, because of the time delay, scoffs at the probability of the Master's coming, and who begins to live like the worldly people around him; [Matthew 24:48-51, Luke 12:45-46, 2 Peter 3:3-4, Jude 1:17-18]

- X There will be weeping and gnashing of teeth. [Matthew 24:51, 8:12, 13:42, 50, 22:13, 25:30, Mark 9:18, Luke 13:28]
- ♦ The command is to <u>Watch and be ready</u>. [Matthew 24:42, 44, 25:13, Mark 13:33, 34, 35, 37, Luke 12:37, 21:36, Acts 20:31, 1 Corinthians 16:13, Ephesians 6:18, 1 Thessalonians 5:6, 2 Timothy 4:5, 1 Peter 4:7, Revelation 3:2-3, 16:15]
- \diamond We are expected to remain faithful until He arrives.

Punishment according to what was entrusted to the individual.

- ✤ And that servant who knew his master's will, and did not prepare himself or do according to his will, shall be beaten with many stripes. [Luke 12:47]
- ✤ But he who did not know, yet committed things deserving of stripes, shall be beaten with few.
 ♦ For everyone to whom much is given, from him much will be required; and to whom much has been committed, of him they will ask the more. [Luke 12:48, Matthew 25:1-30, Luke 8:18, 9:11-26, 19:26, Mark 4:25]
