## Luke 17:3-4 Forgiving Offending Brother

<sup>3</sup> Take heed to yourselves. If your brother sins against you, rebuke him; and if he repents, forgive him. <sup>4</sup> And if he sins against you seven times in a day, and seven times in a day returns to you, saying, 'I repent,' you shall forgive him." NKJV

Facts Revealed:

- ♥ We must stand ready to forgive at the word of one who says he repents. [Matthew 18:15-17, Luke 17:3-4]
  - $\diamond$  If he sins against you, rebuke him and show him the wrong he has done.
  - $\diamond$  If he repents, forgive him.
  - ♦ Since we can not read the heart and mind of our brother, we must take his word that he repents, and be ready to accept his statement.
  - $\diamond$  Like with God, forgiveness is based on repentance.
