Luke 18:15-17 Little Children & Kingdom of God

¹⁵ Then they also brought infants to Him that He might touch them; but when the disciples saw it, they rebuked them. ¹⁶ But Jesus called them to Him and said, "Let the little children come to Me, and do not forbid them; for of such is the kingdom of God. ¹⁷ Assuredly, I say to you, whoever does not receive the kingdom of God as a little child will by no means enter it." NKJV

Facts Revealed:

- The parents wanted their little children to be blessed by Jesus, that He would lay His hands on them and pray for them. [Matthew 19:13, Mark 10:13, Luke 18:15]
- ✤ The disciples thought it a waste of time, an interference or a distraction, and rebuked them.
- ✤ Jesus viewed it differently, and the little children were precious to Him.
 - ☆ "Let the little children come to Me, and do not forbid them; for of such is the Kingdom of Heaven (Kingdom of God)." [Matthew 19:14, Mark 10:13-16, Luke 18:15-17]
 - Assuredly, I say to you, Whoever does not receive the Kingdom of God as a little child will by no means enter it. [Mark 10:15, Luke 18:17]
 - ♦ Jesus had previously used a humble little child as an example of the humble requirement for anyone who desired to enter the Kingdom of Heaven. [Matthew 18:1-14, Luke 9:46-48]

 - ♦ Afterward He departed. [Matthew 19:15]
