Luke 21:1-4 Widow's Mites

And He looked up and saw the rich putting their gifts into the treasury, 2 and He saw also a certain poor widow putting in two mites. 3 So He said, "Truly I say to you that this poor widow has put in more than all; 4 for all these out of their abundance have put in offerings for God, but she out of her poverty put in all the livelihood that she had." NKJV

Facts Revealed:

- God watches what goes into the Treasury of the House of God. [Mark 12:41-44, Luke 21:1-4]
 - ♦ He is most interested in the gift of the heart.
 - ♦ The degree of sacrifice on the part of the giver determines the value of the gift.
 - ♦ This is, because it demonstrates the love for God and commitment in the heart of the giver.
 - ♦ God is not impressed with the size of the gift, but in the condition of the heart.
 - ♦ In the same line, we find God saying:
 - 21 "I hate, I despise your feast days, And I do not savor your sacred assemblies.
 - 22 Though you offer Me burnt offerings and your grain offerings, I will not accept them, Nor will I regard your fattened peace offerings.
 - 23 Take away from Me the noise of your songs, For I will not hear the melody of your stringed instruments.
 - 24 But let **justice** run down like water, And **righteousness** like a mighty stream. NKJV [Amos 5:21-24]

♦ And again He said:

16 For You do not desire sacrifice, or else I would give it;

You do not delight in burnt offering.

17 The sacrifices of God are a **broken spirit**, A **broken and a contrite heart**-These, O God, You will not despise. [Psalm 51:16-17] NKJV

For I desire **mercy** and not sacrifice, And the **knowledge of God** more than burnt offerings. [Hosea 6:6] NKJV

- 6 With what shall I come before the LORD, And bow myself before the High God? Shall I come before Him with burnt offerings, With calves a year old?
- ⁷ Will the LORD be pleased with thousands of rams, Ten thousand rivers of oil? Shall I give my firstborn for my transgression, The fruit of my body for the sin of my soul?
- 8 He has shown you, O man, what is good;

And what does the LORD require of you

But to **do justly**, To **love mercy**, And to **walk humbly with your God**? [Micah 6:6-8] NKJV
