- 20 Then He lifted up His eyes toward His disciples, and said:
- "Blessed are you poor, For yours is the kingdom of God.
- 21 Blessed are you who hunger now, For you shall be filled. Blessed are you who weep now, For you shall laugh.
- 22 Blessed are you when men hate you, And when they exclude you, And revile you, and cast out your name as evil, For the Son of Man's sake.
- 23 Rejoice in that day and leap for joy! For indeed your reward is great in heaven, For in like manner their fathers did to the prophets.

- The Beatitudes express a Blessing from God in respect to various aspects of a Christian's life that might otherwise be viewed as trials, tribulations, and weaknesses.
- Blessed are the ones who are Spiritual though Poor in worldly goods. [Matthew 5:3, Luke 6:20]
 - ❖ Their reward makes all the poverty of earth pale into insignificance because they will inherit the Kingdom of Heaven (Kingdom of God).
 - → The poor who have a heart for God are important to God and a major focus for whom

 Jesus came to preach the Good News of Salvation. [Matthew 11:5, 12:42-44, Luke 4:18, 7:22, 21:2-4,

 James 2:5]
- † Blessed are those who mourn and weep. [Matthew 5:4, Luke 6:21]
 - ♦ For they shall be comforted and laugh.
- ₱ Blessed are the meek. [Matthew 5:5]
 - ❖ People often today count meekness as weakness, but in the Bible it has a totally different perception. An excellent example of a powerful man being meek or humble is found in Moses [Numbers 12:3], a quality highly prized by God Himself. [2 Samuel 22:28, 2 Chronicles 2:14, Psalm 18:20, Matthew 5:5, 18:4, 23:12]
 - ♦ The reward for the meek is that they shall inherit the Earth.
 - ♦ This will be fulfilled in the time of the Kingdom of God on earth.
- Blessed are those who hunger and thirst for righteousness. [Matthew 5:6, Luke 6:21]
 - ❖ Righteousness is a prize worth devoting our lives to acquire, Diligent search for Righteousness has its reward; For they shall be filled. [Matthew 5:6]
 - ♦ Righteousness is the characteristic of the Kingdom of Heaven when Christ will reign over the entire Earth in Righteousness. [Hebrews 1:8-12, Isaiah 1:26-27, 5:16, 11:1-5, 16:5, 32:15-20, 33:5-6, 13-24, 42:1-21, 51:4-8, 54:1-17, 61:10-11, Jeremiah 23:5-6]

- P Blessed are the merciful. [Matthew 5:7]
 - ♦ What does the Lord require of you? But to do justly, To love mercy, And to walk humbly with your God. [Micah 6:8]
 - ♦ The reward of the Merciful is that they shall obtain mercy. [Matthew 5:7, Romans 11:22, 32]
- ₱ Blessed are the pure in heart. [Matthew 5:8]
 - ❖ Purity starts in the heart and is the goal for the Saint of God. [Titus 1:15, Philippians 2:14-15, 1 Timothy 1:1, James 3:17]
 - ♦ The reward of purity is that they shall see God. [Matthew 5:8]
 - ♦ It will be a great blessing in the Kingdom of Heaven for we will be able to come directly to the Throne of Christ and there we will see God with our own eyes. [Isaiah 33:17, Job 19:25-26]
- ₱ Blessed are the peacemakers. [Matthew 5:9]
 - ♦ For they shall be called sons of God. [Matthew 5:9]
 - ♦ God has called us to live in peace. [1 Corinthians 7:15]
 - ♦ The mind controlled by the Spirit is life and peace. [Romans 8:6]
 - → Peace is the goal of the Saint. [Romans 12:18, 14:19, 2 Corinthians 13:11, Galatians 5:22, Ephesians 4:3, Colossians 3:15, 1 Timothy 1:1-2, Titus 3:1-2, Hebrews 12:14, James 3:17-18]
- P Blessed are those who are persecuted for righteousness' sake. [Matthew 5:10]
 - ♦ For theirs is the kingdom of heaven. [Matthew 5:10]
 - ❖ The key for blessing under persecution is when the persecution comes for the sake of your righteousness in living for Christ.
 - ❖ Righteousness is the characteristic of the Kingdom of Heaven when Christ will reign over the entire Earth in Righteousness. [Hebrews 1:8-12, Isaiah 1:26-27, 5:16, 11:1-5, 16:5, 32:15-20, 33:5-6, 13-24, 42:1-21, 51:4-8, 54:1-17, 61:10-11, Jeremiah 23:5-6]
- ₽ Blessed are you when they revile and persecute you, and say all kinds of evil against you **falsely for My sake**. [Matthew 5:11, Luke 6:22-23]
 - ❖ Rejoice and be exceedingly glad, for great is your reward in heaven, for so they persecuted the prophets who were before you. [Matthew 5:12, Luke 6:23]
 - ♦ The **blessing** for being persecuted and slandered, is only for those who are so accused falsely and because of their stand for the sake of Christ Jesus in a world of wickedness. Peter said it is not for doing evil. [1 Peter 4:12-19]
