1 The burden of the word of the Lord to Israel by Malachi.

Israel Beloved of God

- ² "I have loved you," says Yahweh (the Lord). "Yet you say, 'In what way have You loved us?' Was not Esau Jacob's brother?" Says Yahweh (the Lord). "Yet Jacob I have loved;
- ³ But Esau I have hated, And laid waste his mountains and his heritage For the jackals of the wilderness."
- ⁴ Even though Edom has said, "We have been impoverished, But we will return and build the desolate places,"

Thus says the Lord of hosts:

"They may build, but I will throw down; They shall be called the Territory of Wickedness, And the people against whom Yahweh (the Lord) will have indignation forever.

5 Your eyes shall see, And you shall say, Yahweh (the Lord) is magnified beyond the border of Israel.'

- ♦ Yahweh will always have indignation against those who in pride and arrogance trust in themselves instead of turning to Yahweh.
- ❖ In the end the world will see and realize that Yahweh is a God of His word, He always does just exactly as He said He would do.
