- ¹ "And now, O priests, this commandment is for you.
- ² If you will not hear, And if you will not take it to heart, To give glory to My name," Says Yahweh Tsebaovt (the Lord of hosts), "I will send a curse upon you, And I will curse your blessings. Yes, I have cursed them already, Because you do not take it to heart.
- ³ "Behold, I will rebuke your descendants And spread refuse on your faces, The refuse of your solemn feasts; And one will take you away with it.
- ⁴ Then you shall know that I have sent this commandment to you, That My covenant with Levi may continue," Says Yahweh Tsebaovt (the Lord of hosts).

Warning to Corrupt Priests [Malachi 2:1-4, 8-9]
