

Mark 14:10-11 **Betrayal of Jesus Arranged**

¹⁰ Then Judas Iscariot, one of the twelve, went to the chief priests to betray Him to them. ¹¹ And when they heard it, they were glad, and promised to give him money. So he sought how he might conveniently betray Him. NKJV

Facts Revealed:

- ✚ Judas Iscariot the disciple who acted as the treasurer and carried the money box for the disciples, was also a thief who would steal money from it. [[John 12:4-6](#)]
- ✧ Satan entered Judas Iscariot. [[Luke 22:3](#)]
- ✧ Judas went to the Chief Priests and agreed to betray Jesus for thirty pieces of silver. [[Matthew 26:14-15](#), [Mark 14:10-11](#), [Luke 22:3-6](#)]
- ✧ Judas was given the money from the Chief Priest and began looking for an opportunity to betray Jesus. [[Matthew 26:16](#), [Luke 22:5-6](#), [Mark 14:11](#)]
