Jesus returned from healing the little girl at the region of Tyre and Sidon, to the Sea of Galilee Jesus healed the multitude

<sup>29</sup> Jesus departed from there, skirted the Sea of Galilee, and went up on the mountain and sat down there. <sup>30</sup> Then great multitudes came to Him, having with them the lame, blind, mute, maimed, and many others; and they laid them down at Jesus' feet, and He healed them. <sup>31</sup> So the multitude marveled when they saw the mute speaking, the maimed made whole, the lame walking, and the blind seeing; and they glorified the God of Israel.

## Jesus Fed 4,000 and went to Magdala

32 Now Jesus called His disciples to Himself and said, "I have compassion on the multitude, because they have now continued with Me three days and have nothing to eat. And I do not want to send them away hungry, lest they faint on the way." 33 Then His disciples said to Him, "Where could we get enough bread in the wilderness to fill such a great multitude?" 34 Jesus said to them, "How many loaves do you have?" And they said, "Seven, and a few little fish." 35 So He commanded the multitude to sit down on the ground. 36 And He took the seven loaves and the fish and gave thanks, broke them and gave them to His disciples; and the disciples gave to the multitude. 37 So they all ate and were filled, and they took up seven large baskets full of the fragments that were left. 38 Now those who ate were four thousand men, besides women and children. 39 And He sent away the multitude, got into the boat, and came to the region of Magdala. Jesus healed the multitude [Matthew 15:29-31, Mark 7:31-37]

- Jesus returned and skirted the Sea of Galilee to the region of Decapolis, went up the mountain and sat down.
- ♣ Great multitudes came to Him with all their sick, and Jesus healed them. [Matthew 15:30-31]
- They glorified the God of Israel when they saw the lame walking, the blind seeing, the maimed made whole, the mute speaking, and many others.

Jesus Fed 4,000 [Matthew 15:32-38, Mark 8:1-10]

- The multitude was very great and had nothing to eat, so Jesus had compassion on the multitude who had been with Him for three days. [Mark 8:1-3]
- Desus asked the disciples to find how many loaves were available, they said, "seven." [Mark 8:4-5]
- With seven loaves and a few little fish, out of compassion for the multitude, Jesus fed 4,000 men besides all the women and children.
  - ♦ After they had all eaten and were satisfied, the disciples gathered up seven large baskets full of fragments that were left over from the seven loaves and the few small fish.

From there Jesus went by boat to the region of Magdala (Dalmanutha) [Matthew 15:39, Mark 8:10]

People from Magdala would be called Magdalenes like Mary Magdalene. [Matthew 27:56, Mark 16:9, John 20:1]
