Matthew 9:32-34 **Demon cast out / Mute Spoke**

32 As they went out, behold, they brought to Him a man, mute and demon-possessed. 33 And when the demon was cast out, the mute spoke. And the multitudes marveled, saying, "It was never seen like this in Israel!" 34 But the Pharisees said, "He casts out demons by the ruler of the demons." NKJV

Facts Revealed:

- P Deliverance from demon possession, allowed the mute to speak.
- The people were amazed, they had never seen or heard of miracles like this.
- The Pharisees, who made themselves the highest authority of their religion, who established all the rules of Judaism, said Jesus "casts out demons by the ruler of the demons."
 - ♦ It was in this setting that Jesus gave the warning against the Unforgivable Sin. [Matthew 12:22-32, Mark 3:20-30]
 - ♦ Blasphemy against the Holy Spirit will not be forgiven. [Matthew 12:22-32, Mark 3:20-30, Luke 12:10]
 - ❖ To claim that the work of the Holy Spirit, is the work of Satan, Beelzebub, or the ruler of the demons, is blasphemy against (speaking evil against) the Holy Spirit. This is unforgivable.
