Numbers 10:1-10 Silver Trumpets

¹ And the LORD spoke to Moses, saying: ² "Make two silver trumpets for yourself; you shall make them of hammered work; you shall use them for calling the assembly and for directing the movement of the camps.

Calling Assembly

³ When they blow both of them, all the assembly shall gather before you at the door of the tabernacle of meeting. ⁴ But if they blow only one, then the leaders, the heads of the divisions of Israel, shall gather to you.

Sounding Advance

⁵ When you sound the advance, the camps that lie on the east side shall then begin their journey. ⁶ When you sound the advance the second time, then the camps that lie on the south side shall begin their journey; they shall sound the call for them to begin their journeys.

Congregation gathered together

⁷ And when the congregation is to be gathered together, you shall blow, but not sound the advance. ⁸ The sons of Aaron, the priests, shall blow the trumpets; and these shall be to you as an ordinance forever throughout your generations.

Sounding Alarm

⁹ When you go to war in your land against the enemy who oppresses you, then you shall sound an alarm with the trumpets, and you will be remembered before the LORD your God, and you will be saved from your enemies.

Celebrations of Gladness

¹⁰ Also in the day of your gladness, in your appointed feasts, and at the beginning of your months, you shall blow the trumpets over your burnt offerings and over the sacrifices of your peace offerings; and they shall be a memorial for you before your God: I am the LORD your God." NKJV

Facts Revealed:

- ☆ Yehowah commanded Moses to make two Silver Trumpets for calling assembly and for directing the movement of the camps. [Numbers 10:1-2]
 - ♦ Sounding both trumpets, all the <u>assembly</u> of the Children of Israel shall gather before you at the door of the Tabernacle of Meeting.
 - ♦ Sounding only one trumpet, the leaders, the heads of the divisions of Israel shall gather and <u>assemble</u> to you.
- ☆ When you sound the first <u>advance</u>, The camps of Judah Issachar Zebulun on the East shall begin their journey. [Numbers 2:3-9, 10:5]
- ✤ Followed by the Levitical tribes of Gershon and Merari with the Tabernacle structure.
- ☆ The second <u>advance</u>, the camps of **Reuben** Simeon Gad on the South shall begin their journey. [Numbers 2:10-16, 10:6]
- ✤ Followed by the Levitical tribe of Kohath carrying the Holy Things, of the Tabernacle which travel in the midst of the tribes.
- ☆ Then the camp of Ephraim Manasseh Benjamin on the West shall begin their journey. [Numbers 2:18-24]

- Then the camp of **Dan** Asher Naphtali on the North shall begin their journey. [Numbers 2:25-31]
- \Rightarrow The sons of Aaron the priests shall blow the trumpets.
- ☆ When you go to war in your land against the enemy who oppresses you, then you shall sound an <u>alarm</u> with the trumpets. You will be remembered before Yehowah Eloheykm (the Lord your God), and you will be saved from your enemies.
- ☆ In the **day of your gladness**, in your appointed feasts, at the beginning of your months.
- ☆ You shall blow the trumpets over your Burnt Offerings, and over your Peace Offerings.
- \Rightarrow They shall be a memorial for you before Eloheykm (your God).
- \Rightarrow I am Yehowah Eloheykm (the Lord your God).
