Numbers 20:1 Miriam Dies

¹ Then the children of Israel, the whole congregation, came into the Wilderness of Zin in the first month, and the people stayed in Kadesh; and Miriam died there and was buried there. NKJV

Facts Revealed:

- ☆ It had taken eleven days travel from Mount Sinai (Horeb) to arrive on the outskirts of the Promised Land in the Wilderness of Paran at Kadesh from which Moses had sent out the twelve spies to review the land and its inhabitants. [Deuteronomy 1:2, Numbers 13:17-29]
- ☆ Forty days later they had brought back the report that cast fear in the hearts of the congregation which began the 40 years wandering in the Wilderness. [Numbers 13:26-29, 14:32-35]
- ☆ Now they came into the Wilderness of Zin in the first month and are still at Kadesh where they stayed until Miriam died and was buried.
- ☆ Based on the timing for arrival at both the Wilderness of Paran and the Wilderness of Zin, it
 would appear that they may be one and the same place.
